This email is in support of LCO 3471, the police accountability bill.

I believe Connecticut should:

- Eliminate 'qualified immunity' for law enforcement. Police officers who commit civil rights violations would now be subject to civil liability themselves.
- Create a **duty to intervene** when a police officer witnesses another law enforcement officer using unreasonable, excessive, or illegal use of force.
- Create the figure of a **fully independent Inspector General** tasked with the responsibility of conducting investigations involved in use of force cases.
- Give local police civilian review boardsreal teeth and subpoena power.
- Requires police departments to get rid of their military-grade equipment within six months.
- Establish strict limits on traffic stops and searches, limiting the definition of what constitutes probable cause.
