

Sent from my iPhone. I believe that every Connecticut municipality over 50,000 people should have a police civilian review board to handle complaints against local police by citizens . The police civilian review board should be composed of 10 residents representing a cross section of the municipality by race, gender and age and be residents of the municipality over 21 years of age and be appointed by the chief executive of the municipality and the chief legislative body of the municipality for a period of 4 years subject to renewal . Members can be expelled for criminal behavior, incompetence or not showing for more than 3 monthly meeting during the course of a year .
