

My name is Dean Bedard, im currently being held at Bridgeport Correctional Center. We have a big Sanitary problem here at the facility. We are Promised one Cell clean up a week which almost never happens, its more like one cell clean up a month... resulting in mass dust build up and everything else that we track in our cells from our shoes. We are very limited on Supplies such as cleaning liquids, Mopheads, Soaps, Etc. The tier men who clean the blocks/Dorms are limited to what they clean due to lack of supplies. There has been multiple Scabies and merca cases within the last 8 months in one block alone.

Another huge issue is the dust build up in the Vents around the facility, especially the Vents in our cells which we breathe in all day.

Another thing is lack of programs here at BCC. They only have school for achieving your GED, it would be nice to see some college classes offered or trades.
