
Dear Mr. Vazquez,

Thank you for contacting the Inmates' Legal Aid Program (ILAP). This letter is in response to four telephone calls you placed with our office on March 17. On the first call you said you were unable to attend to have your hearing in front of the General Assembly and you wanted a legal call to discuss what is next. On the second call you called back asking if the call was scheduled. On the final two calls, when Asha answered you hung up the phone.

If you were unable to attend the hearing, you have to reach out to the Claims Commissioner's office to find out what happened. The General Assembly could have went forward with the hearing or rescheduled it for a new date. Whatever the outcome of the hearing, they will provide you with a notice of the decision.
