Research Needed/Data Agenda:

The SDE issues two forms to schools and pre-schools: The Early Childhood Health Assessment Record and the Health Assessment Record. Both forms must be filled out before a child can attend pre-school and grades K-12 in Connecticut. Our Work Group has suggested a bill be introduced in the Legislature to mandate electronic record keeping of these forms that can be shared. Identification of individuals would be kept private. Currently, these forms are filed and kept in the local schools for their use only.
