Headline Indicators (2-3)

1. % of children living in families where no parent has full time, year-round employment
2. Families eating together
3. Chronic absenteeism

Secondary Indicators (4-6)

2. Food insecurity
3. Young low income parents
4. Kids in out-of-home placements
5. Children in poverty
6. Housing insecurity
7. (Extra One: Children with incarcerated Parents or Parents with criminal record or substance abuse history)

2. Is the data for families eating together validated for younger children?

3. Data for “Ages and Stages”
