Anthony G. Alessi, M.D., M.M.M., is the director of the UConn NeuroSport Program. Dr. Alessi graduated from the University of Rome, Italy, and completed his residency and neuromuscular fellowship at the University of Michigan. He earned his master's degree in medical management from Carnegie Mellon University. Dr. Alessi specializes in neurology, electrodiagnostic medicine, and sports neurology.

Dr. Alessi is an expert in the diagnosis, treatment, and rehabilitation of sports-related neurologic injuries such as concussions and other forms of traumatic brain injury, spinal injuries, and peripheral nerve damage. Additionally, he provides counseling to athletes who suffer from chronic neurologic conditions including stroke, migraine, multiple sclerosis, and epilepsy.

Dr. Alessi serves as a neurologic consultant to many athletic organizations including UConn's Division of Athletics, New York Yankees Player Development, NFL Players Association, Connecticut State Boxing Commission, Connecticut Sun, and the Norwich Free Academy.
