

SENATE BILL No. 58.

PUBLIC ACT NO. 588

AN ACT REQUIRING POLIOMYELITIS VACCINATIONS  
FOR EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL CHILD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Assembly convened:*

SECTION 1. Any board of education may require each child to be protected against poliomyelitis by vaccination before being permitted to attend a public school under its jurisdiction, unless such child presents a certificate from a physician, approved by the director of health of the town, city or borough, practicing in or near the town where such child resides, certifying that, in the opinion of such physician, such vaccination would not be prudent on account of the physical condition of such child or a statement from the parents or guardian of such child that such vaccination would be contrary to the religious beliefs of such child.

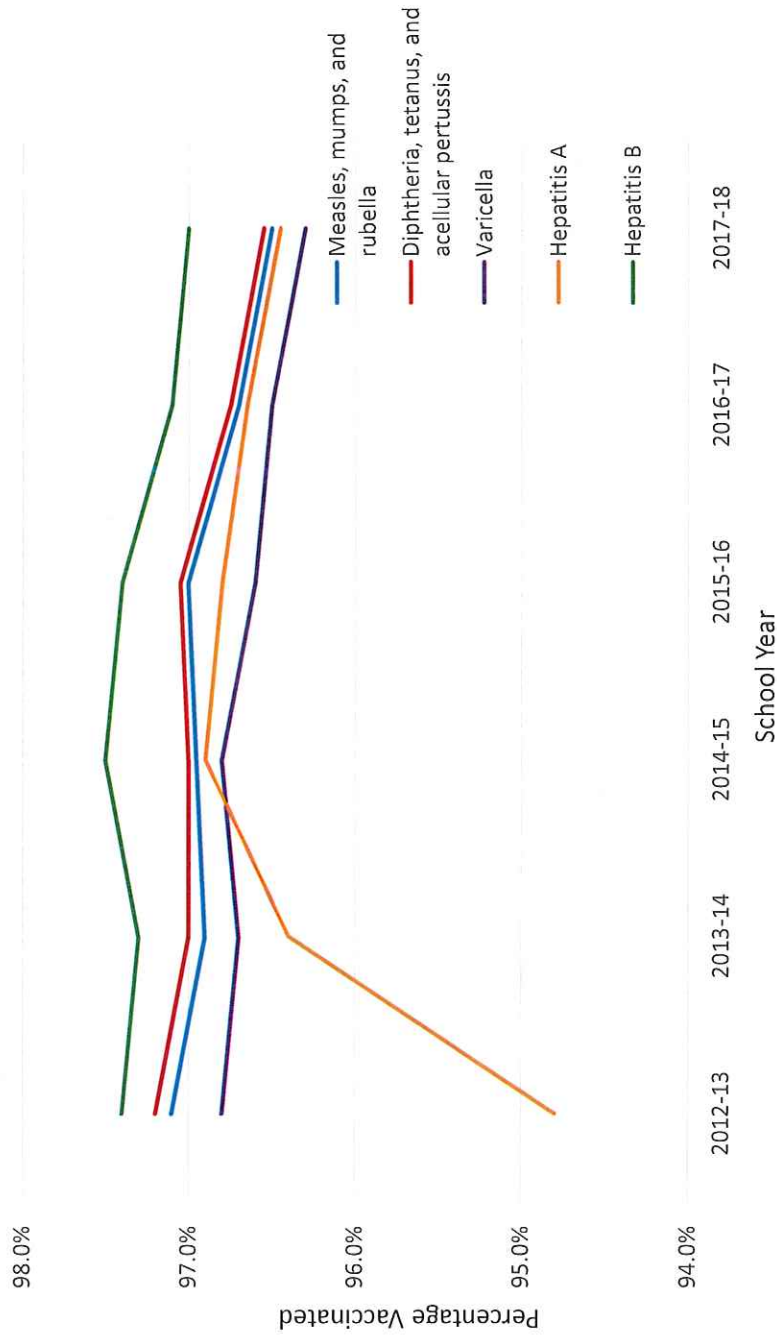
SEC. 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1959.



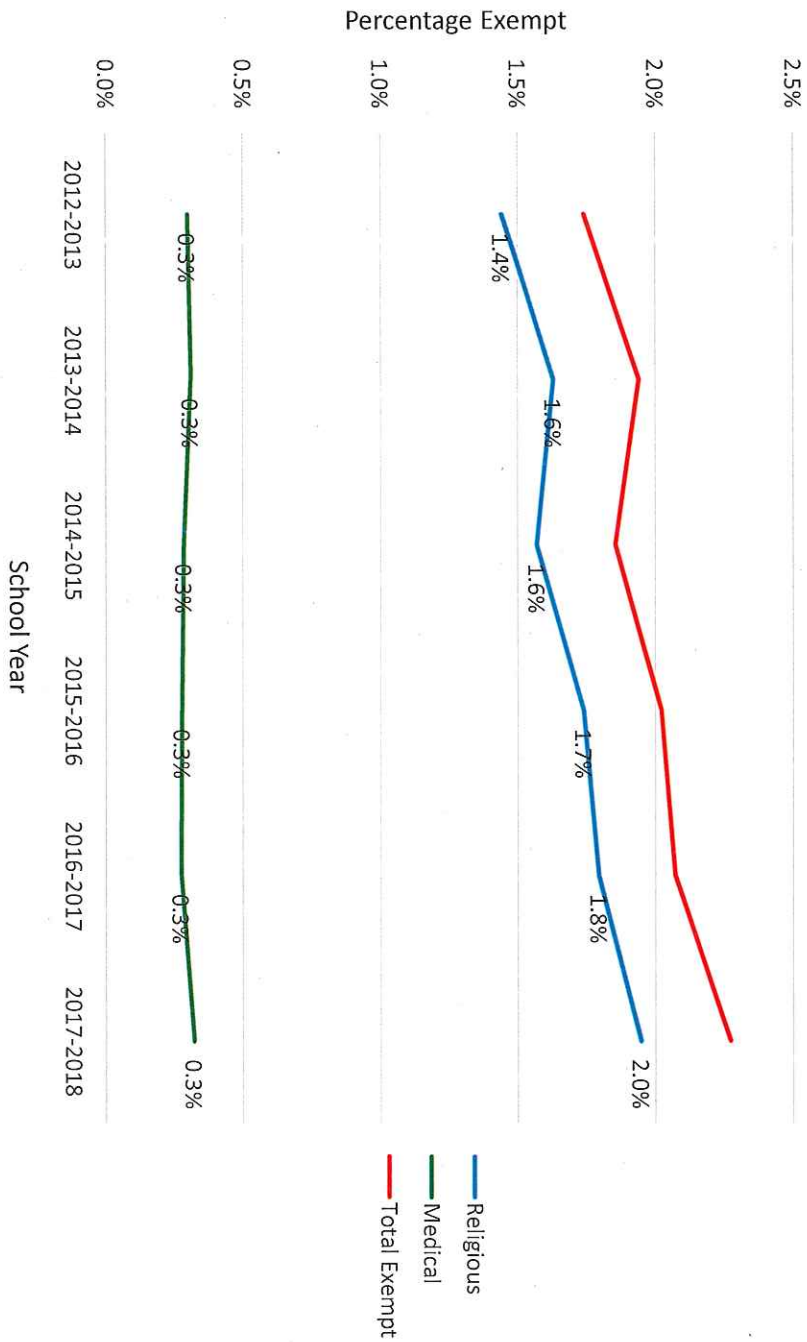
