To whom it may concern:

I am writing you today because I have learned that CT legislators are considering removing the Religious Exemption for vaccinations.

I am OPPOSED to the removal of the Religious Exemption because not only is it a violation of religious liberty, it is also a violation of all schools' non-discrimination statements, that declare that no students will be discriminated against on the basis of their religious beliefs.

There is no public health crisis currently ongoing in the state of CT that would warrant the removal of this exemption, and it is an infringement upon the rights of CT citizens to freely exercise their religious beliefs.

Also, I implore you to think of the long-term consequences that this type of action will have on the lives of these families that use the exemption. Kids who love school, who are excelling at it, will need to be told that they can no longer attend.
