Members of the Committee,

I'm upset because this is not a public hearing. We deserve a chance to testify on a bill. There is a correct process that needs to be followed, and that hasn't happened here, while you try to take away our religious freedom.

I used to be pro vaccine. That all changed when I was pregnant with my now 4 year old, and discovered that aborted fetal tissue is used in vaccines. That was an eye opener, because I am pro-life.
