I'm writing because I have been informed that there is a going to be a new bill to potentially eliminate the Religious excemption in Ct .Im very concerned as I have a sincere religious objection to vaccinations and work full time as a Nurse assistant. I will have to quit my job in order to homeschool my children and it would inflict a hardship on my family to do so .I hope you take into consideration that parents work and forcing them to quit thier jobs to homeschool is going to inflict hardship on familes .I will not vaccinate my children under any circumstances and most parents will not be bullied into doing so ethier .

I would also like to inform you that I know parents who use the Religious excemption because they need a medical excemption but can not obtain one from thier doctor as most doctors will not grant them .

Furthermore there are parents who use the religious excemption to opt out of the flu shot and get the recommended vaccines for thier children. In my opinion these parents are misusing the excemption but there should be a philosophical excemption for these people.
