Funding is available for transfer from this account due to the following:

• <u>Personal Services</u> - The commission has funding for a temporary position that it is currently vacant.

Funding is needed in this account due to the following:

• <u>Other Expenses</u> - The commission is requesting a transfer for consultant costs to conduct research and related printing costs for a socio economic study. This transfer reflects a 143% increase over its' appropriation of \$27,290. The five year average expenditure in Other Expenses has been \$36,677.

Holdbacks and Lapses

This transfer is not anticipated to affect the agency's ability to achieve their portion of the Statewide Hiring Reduction Lapse in Personal Services of \$2,020. This transfer will reduce our projected lapse in this account by the amount of the transfer.

Rescissions

This transfer is not anticipated to affect the agency's ability to achieve their portion of the Governor's rescissions in Personal Services of \$4,468.

- 1. Has the commission contracted out for these services in previous fiscal years?
- 2. If these funds are transferred and presuming that a contract would have to go out to bid, do you anticipate the study to be completed by the end of the fiscal year?

Funding is available for transfer from this account due to the following:

• <u>Medicaid</u> - Due to the magnitude of the annual Medicaid appropriation, funds are available for transfer in the short term. However, this account currently has a projected year end deficiency of at least \$40 million.

Funding is needed in this account due to the following:

 <u>Connecticut Children's Medical Center</u> - This account, CCMC, has historically been funded on a grant basis and has not been provided deficiency or FAC funding. Funds are needed to address CCMC's current fiscal situation. According to the Office of Health Care Access's Financial Status Report, in 2013, CCMC experienced an operating loss of \$10.5 million, offset by non-operating revenues of \$10.8 million. These funds are in addition to CCMC's annual \$15,579,200 grant.

Holdback and Lapses

This transfer will not affect the agency's ability to achieve the Personal Services and Other Expenses holdbacks of \$1,592,200.

Deficiency Issues

This transfer will likely increase the current projected deficiency for Medicaid from \$40 million to \$50 million.
