These estimates were prepared under a short time frame and could be revised after further analysis. For bills on the agenda with proposed substitutes, the fiscal impact is based on the substitute language.

III. COMMITTEE BILLS FOR REVIEW

The substitute language eliminates the requirement that each basic and review training program conducted by DESPP or a municipal police department include a training on cognitive disorders and diseases. Removing this provision eliminates the \$50,000 cost to DESPP as well as the potential cost to municipalities identified in the original fiscal note. As a result of the substitute language, there is no fiscal impact arising from the bill.
