These estimates were prepared under a short time frame and could be revised after further analysis. For bills on the agenda with proposed substitutes, the fiscal impact is based on the substitute language.

A. Bills for Review

1. sHB 5259 - An Act Concerning Adoption of the Connecticut Uniform Limited Liability Company Act - refer to fiscal note on file copy 525 - Proposed Substitute Language

The Secretary of the State's CONCORD business database will need to be reprogrammed at a cost of approximately \$60,000.

2. **sHB 5561 – An Act Concerning Fairness in Consumer Contracts –** refer to fiscal note in file copy 414 – *Proposed Substitute Language*

The bill also declares six types of contract terms unconscionable if included in a consumer contract but does not provide for state enforcement therefore there is no fiscal impact to the state.

The bill requires the Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA) to establish a memorial on State Capitol grounds to honor certain veterans within available appropriations, resulting in a one-time, potential cost of less than \$50,000.
