This item incorporates PA 13-244 into OPM's regulations. PA 13-244 allows municipalities to increase the veterans' additional property tax exemption to three times the veterans' base exemption for certain veterans. OPM reimburses municipalities for this exemption. The act increases the cost to fully fund the program. However, as the grant can be pro-rated in years in which the appropriation is insufficient to fund full
