This regulation adds eight more medical conditions to the list of conditions that qualify for medicinal marijuana resulting in a revenue gain to the state depending on the number of people who qualify and apply for the program. As of July 1, 2018, there are 26,673 people that qualify for the program and pay the \$100 annual fee. In FY 17, these fees generated \$2.1 million in revenue for the state.
