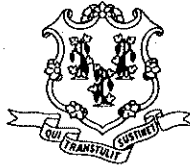

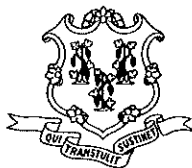

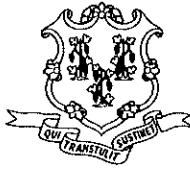
The regulation removes various fees for medical marijuana licenses and registrations resulting in a revenue loss of at least \$30,000 per year.

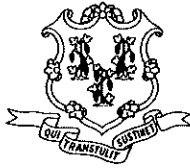
The regulations could result in a minimal cost to other state agencies or municipalities associated with inspecting, updating, or closing underwater storage tanks. The costs could range from \$450 to over \$10,000, depending on the tank. However, it is anticipated that these costs could be occurred in the outyears and will offset larger costs associated with repair, remediation, and possible property damage related to outdated tanks.
