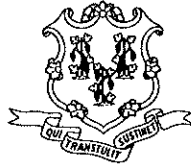

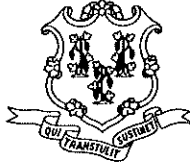
FY 24-FY 25 budget appropriated \$500,000 in both years to the Fallen Officer Fund. \$800,000 is remaining in the fund.
