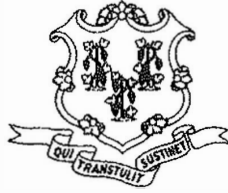

OFA has reviewed the state and municipal fiscal impact of item 2026-009 for the Department of Public Health (DPH) for this month's meeting.¹ The following table summarizes our review.

The projected fiscal impact provided by DPH (\$3,600) represents the potential maximum biennial revenue loss associated with the increase of specimen collection facilities.
