ECS FORMULA

Formula is phased in from FY 19 to either FY 26 (for underfunded towns) or FY 32 (for overfunded towns)

- The formula was revised, and a phase-in schedule established, as part of the FY 18 and FY 19 Budget. The phase-in schedule began in FY 19.

The phase in schedule has been changed multiple times but currently:
Towns that are underfunded according to the formula will reach full funding in FY 26.

- Towns that are overfunded receive, from FY 22 to FY 25, the same grants as in the prior FY, and then resume the formula phase-in beginning FY 26. These towns will reach full funding in FY 32.

- Each Alliance District's full funding level is the greater of the full funding amount, the prior FY grant, and the FY 17 grant.

For FY 23-FY 27, there are 36 Alliance Districts: the 33 lowest-performing districts and the three that were among the lowest-performing in the previous program cycle (FY 18-FY 22). These districts must participate in the program in order to receive the entire ECS grant.



Fully implementing ECS in FY 25 would require an additional \$50.2 million.
