"[P]ublic education in our Nation is committed to the control of state and local authorities."

Federal courts should not ordinarily "intervene in the resolution of conflicts which arise in the daily operation of school systems."

"[L]ocal school boards must be permitted to establish and apply their curriculum in such a way as to transmit community values."

STATE INFLUENCES ON CURRICULUM







CONNECTICUT GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Passes laws requiring general subject matter topics and, occasionally, courses

STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

Approves resolutions adopting standards, frameworks, model materials, and statewide assessments

FRAMEWORKS AND STANDARDS

Provide guidelines for designing curriculum and assessments representing what students need to know and be able to do

LOCAL INFLUENCES ON CURRICULUM

SCHOOL BOARDS

Hire administrators to facilitate curriculum development; respond to challenges to curriculum

CURRICULUM COORDINATORS

Serve as districtwide administrators or school-level department heads

EDUCATORS

Assist with writing and implementing curriculum

FEDERAL INFLUENCES ON CURRICULUM

20 USC § 1232a

Prohibits any federal program from supervising or controlling public schools' curriculum, program of instruction, or textbooks

THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH

Develops policy initiatives that presidential administrations and the U.S. Department of Education incentivize states to follow

CONGRESS

Passes laws incentivizing states to participate with initiatives to avoid losing federal dollars
