#### IMPACT OF RIVERVIEW DATA ON ALOS

- Number of discharges increased from 33 to 50 over past three quarters.
- As we move further from implementation, the TRUE ALOS of Riverview cases is increasingly inflating the overall ALOS
- Recommendation: Moving forward, remove Riverview ALOS from reports

## **ED** Delays

- CCMC has highest volume of youth delayed in EDs
- Overall, Q3 07 had lower volume than previous two quarters of 2007
  - When admissions to medical beds are included in Yale counts, that facility has second highest count of ED delays (17, 16, and 8 respectively)
  - Other relatively high volume ED delays are Middlesex (10, 6, 2), NBGH (10, 3, 2), L&M (4, 9, 1) & St Francis (4,3,6)
