Peer Support Unit

- Number of Families helped (not unduplicated):
 - > April 413
 - ➢ May 424
 - ➤ June 435
 - ➢ July 370
- We have participated in 195 meetings with members, both in their home and out in the community

Peer Support Unit (cont.)

- Peer/ Family Peer Specialists continue to be involved in the Wrap Around Initiative sponsored by a grant from CHDI. This initiative is intended to assist in the implementation of wrap around practice in the state.
- One Peer, Curtis Willey, has completed the CCAR Recovery Coach training and is working to help support members who are recovering from addiction. Another Peer, Lucy Marinuzzi is schedule for the October training.
- Peer referrals for Spanish only speaking members are being triaged by Diana Kenney, a bilingual Peer Specialist, who will work with the member if the member is not comfortable working with an interpreter.

Peer Support Unit (cont.)

- Met with 35 Families in EDs in Q2 2009
- Attended ongoing onsite facility based rounds with St. Francis, CARES, Hall-Brooke
- Attended 54 Community Outreach Meetings: Support Groups, Planning Grant meetings, NAMI National Conference, CCAR, Forums, Presentations, Crisis Planning training
- Referred over 53 families to Care Coordination through the System of Care
