## Adolescent SBIRT Training Plan

The Connecticut Adolescent Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment (A-SBIRT) Initiative will utilize a three-tiered approach to training. The core tier one training will be presented in one day and will prepare Trainees to utilize A-SBIRT techniques with youth with whom they work and interact. Target groups for tier one training include but are not limited to: DCF, EMPS, pediatricians and primary care providers, FQHCs, school-based health centers, community providers, prevention practitioners, faith community and others. Tier two will consist of those individuals wishing to become Trainers in order to train others in A-SBIRT. The tier two ""Training of Trainers" will be held over two and a half days. Tier three will include those experienced and proficient trainers who have been invited to become Training Champions. Training Champions will receive extra training that will allow them to lead "Training of Trainers" courses in A-SBIRT.
