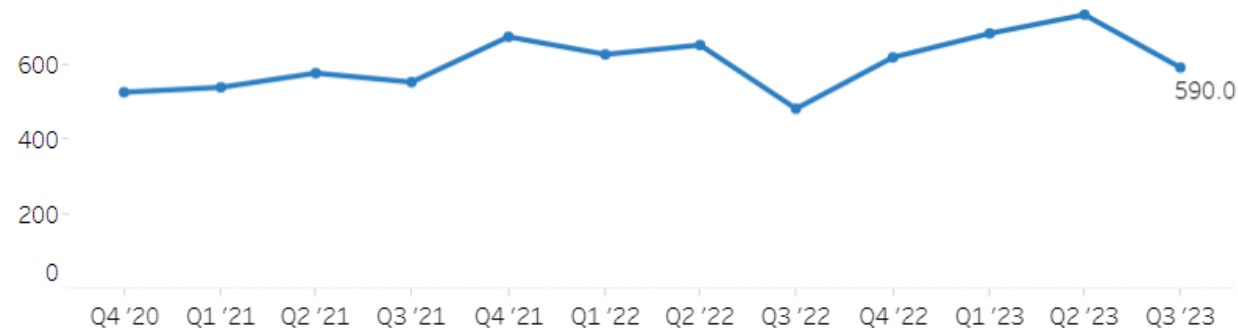

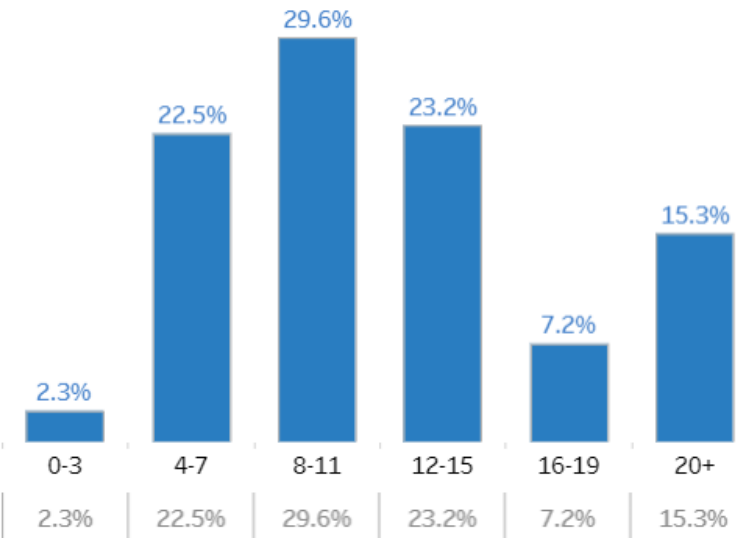

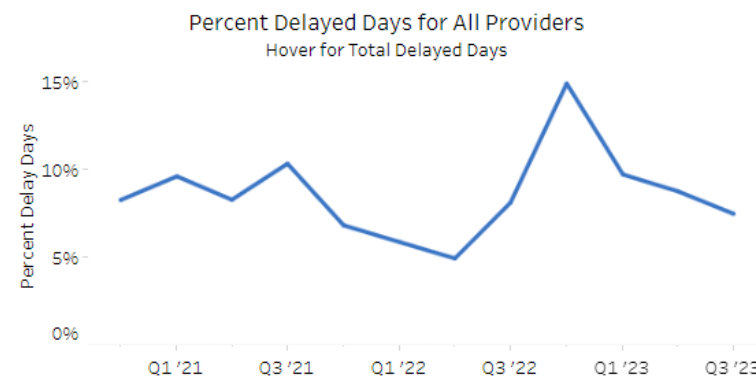

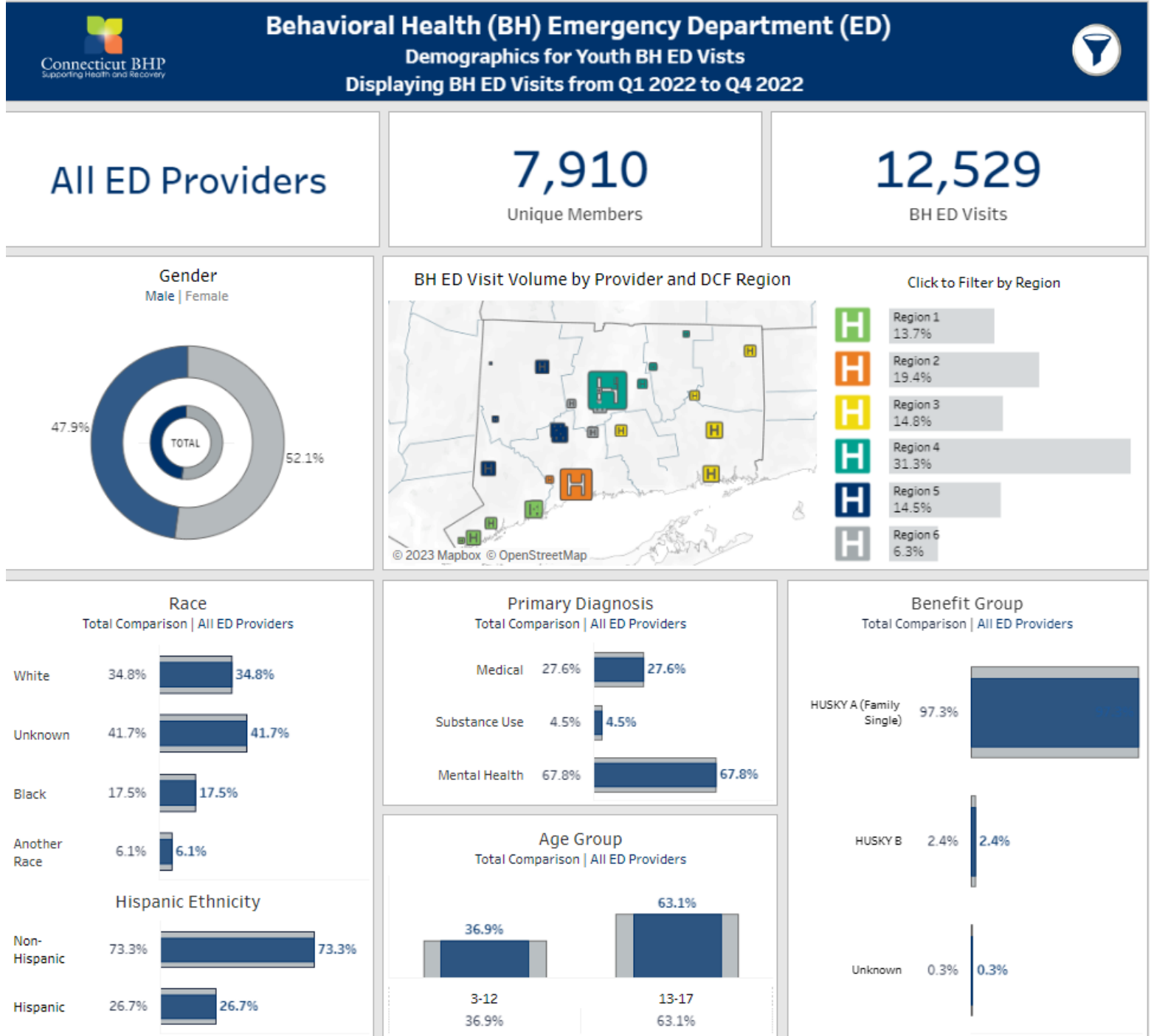

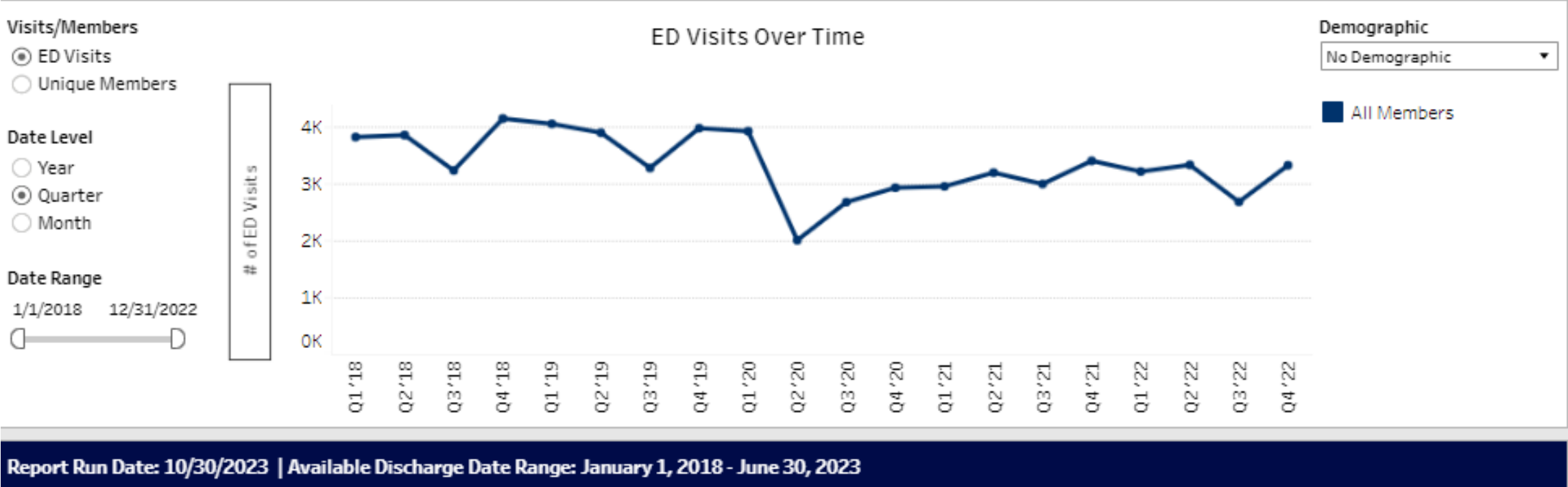

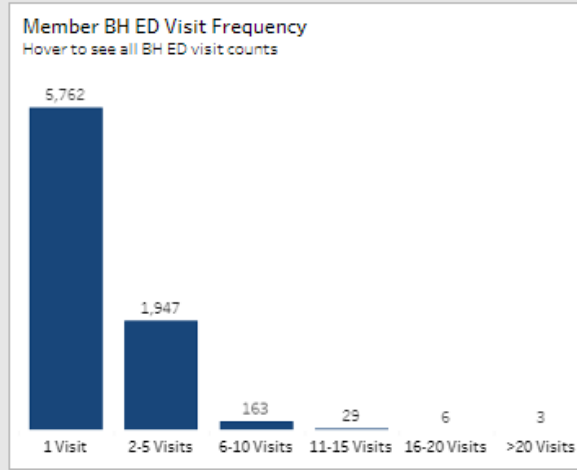
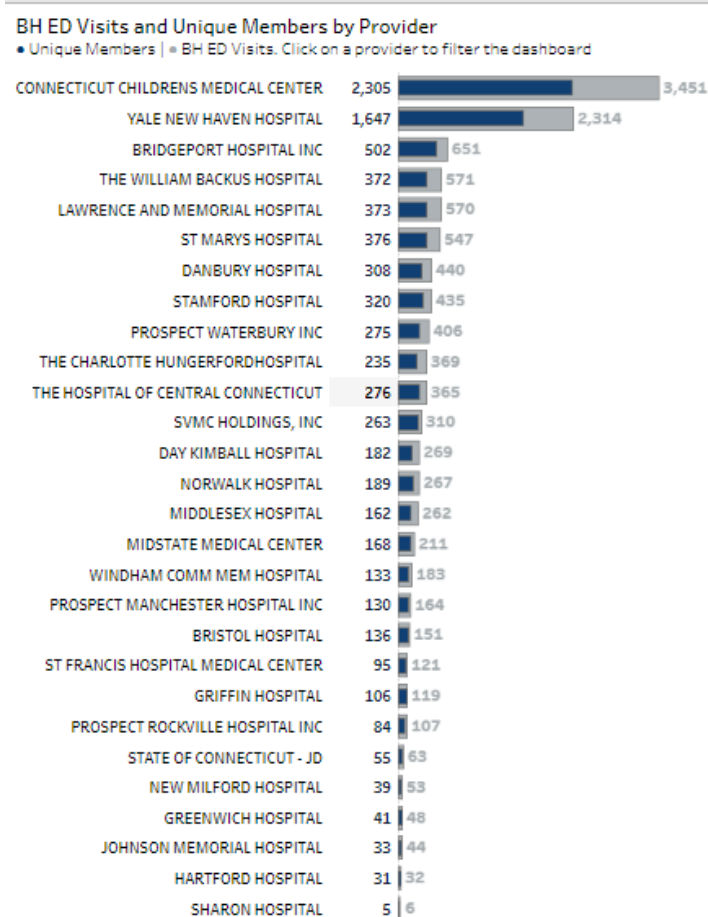


# ED Visits Over Time (1/1/18 – 12/31/22)



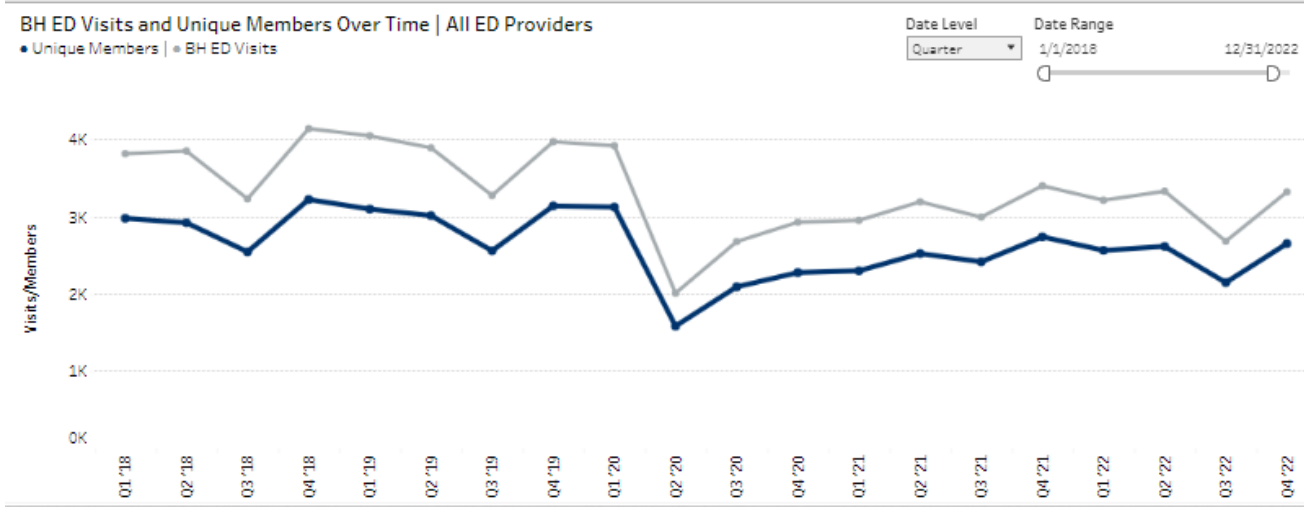

## Emergency Department (ED) "Stuck" Analysis

### ED Stuck Volume Over Time



From October 1, 2020 to June 30, 2023, there were 7,053 cases (3,961 unique members) identified as stuck in the Emergency Department (ED). Of those ED Stuck cases, 49.5% (n=3,490) were recommended for inpatient level of care and 44.6% (n=3,144) cases resulted in an inpatient stay at discharge from the ED.

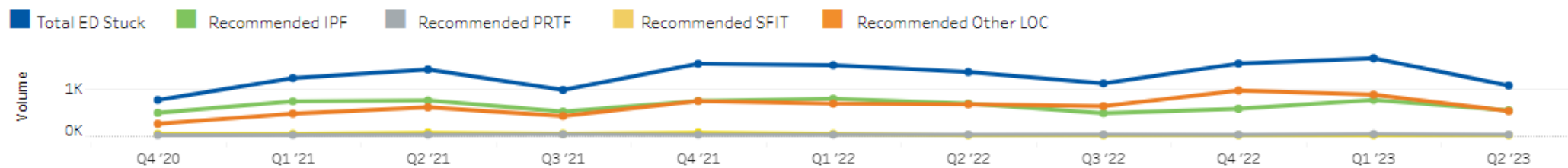

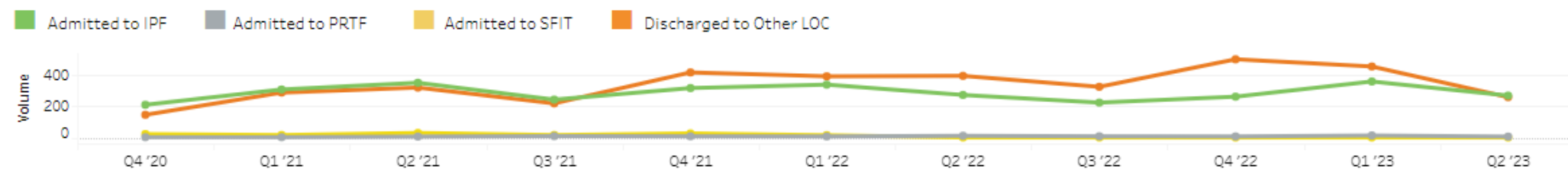

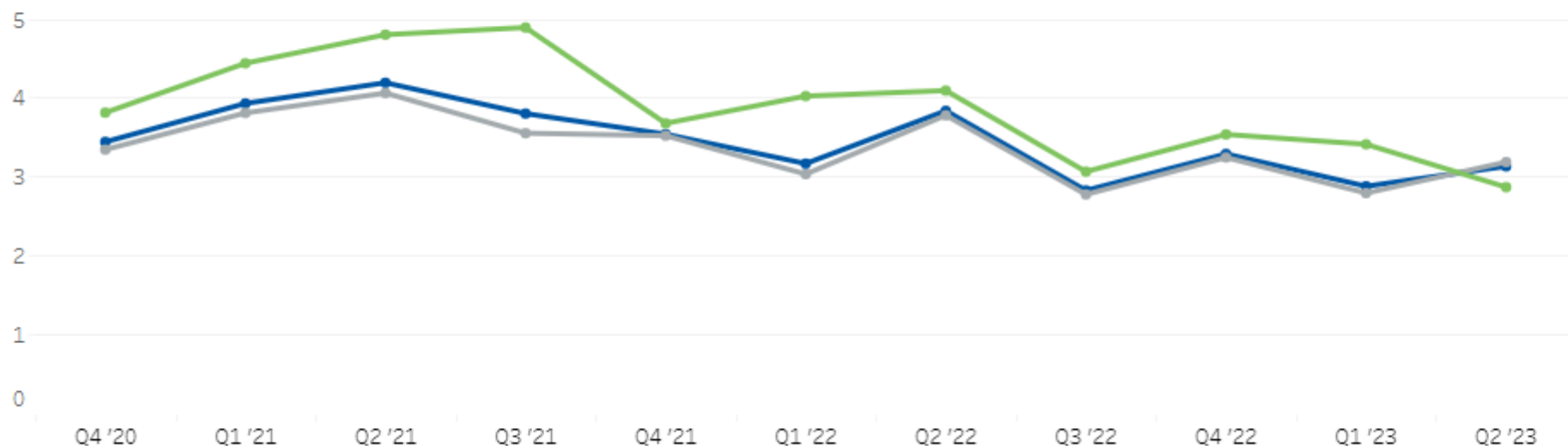

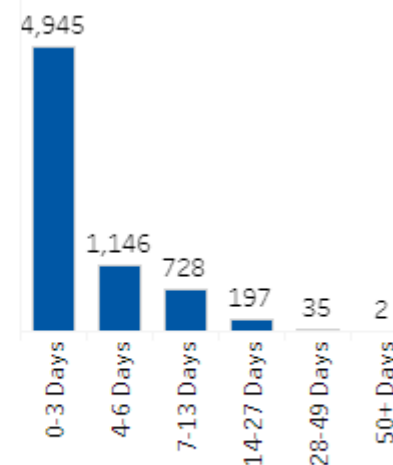
