Co-Management Criteria

If a member presents with any of these (6) diagnoses it is cause for automatic referral to the assigned MCO:

Substance Abuse and Neonatal Withdrawal

Child/Adolescent Obesity

Child/Adolescent Type II Diabetes

Sickle Cell

Eating Disorders

Medical Detox

Be advised the following are examples of cases that may also need co-management:

Barriers to Medical Care

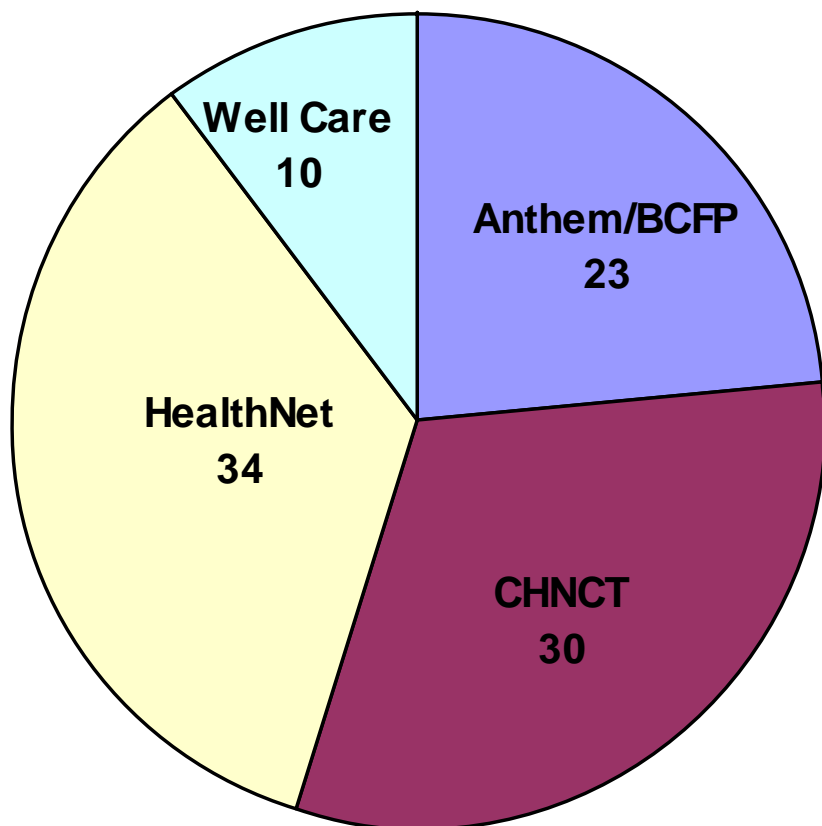

3rd Quarter MCO Referrals 2007

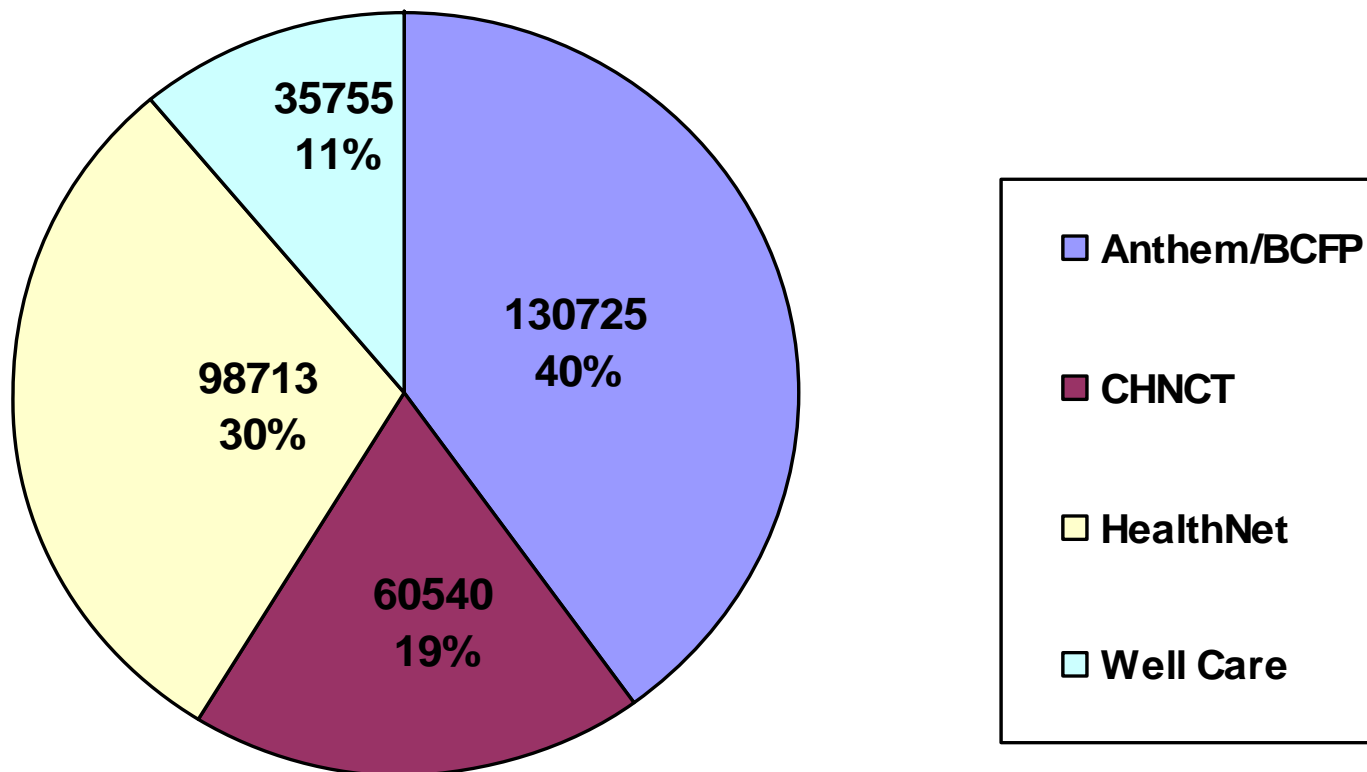

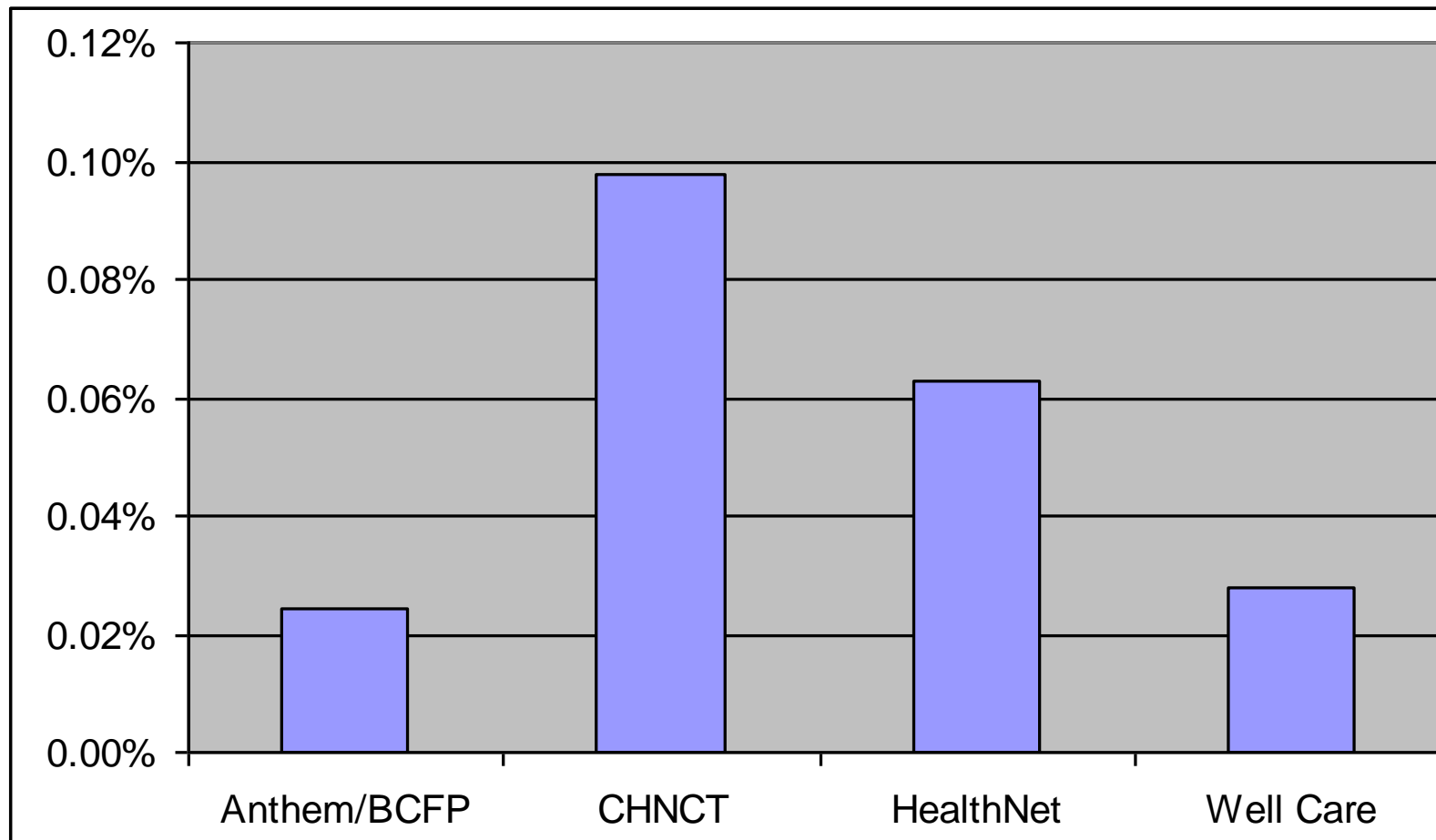
HUSKY Enrollment for Quarter 3 2007
