Background

- Effective March 1, 2012, the Department implemented a family planning limited benefit coverage group (M07 & M08)
- This coverage group is not restricted by age or gender
- Providers include physicians, APRNs, CNMs, ambulatory surgical centers, clinics, independent labs, and outpatient hospital

Background (cont.)

- Coverage include family planning services as well as family planning-related services:
 - Comprehensive physical examinations
 - Screening and treatment services for sexually transmitted diseases/illness
 - Voluntary sterilizations in accordance with federal guidelines
 - Contraceptive services and supplies
 - Human papilloma virus (HPV) vaccinations (including males).

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- Family planning-related surgical treatments (for example, perforated uterus as a result of an IUD
- Pregnancy tests

Relationship to ACA Coverage

This benefit does not satisfy the ACA insurance mandate requirement

Connecticut has elected to maintain the benefit

Outcomes

Additional Detail

- Over the past two years, approximately 5,000 unduplicated individuals received family planning and related services
- 95% of those in the coverage group were screened, and where needed, treated, for sexually transmitted diseases such as chlamydia & gonorrhea
- 50% of members were screened for HIV
- 100% of participating children under age 18 received the HPV vaccine
