

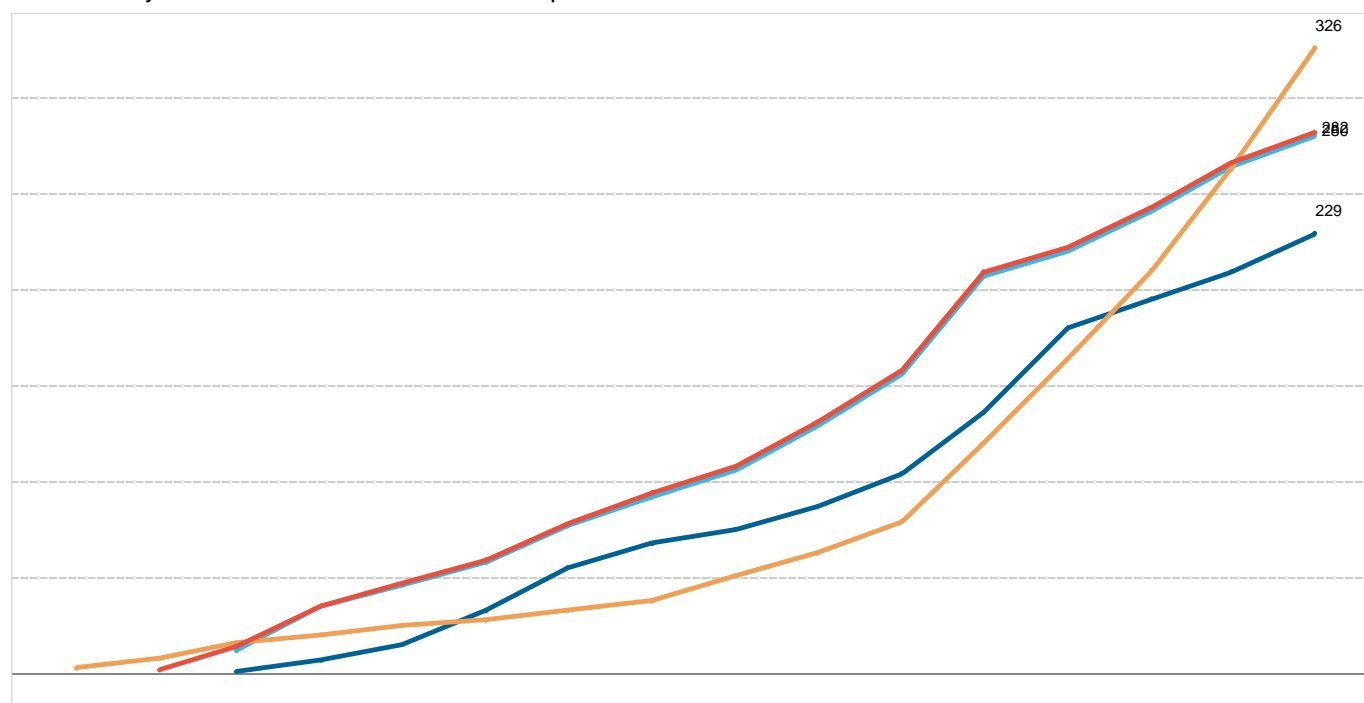

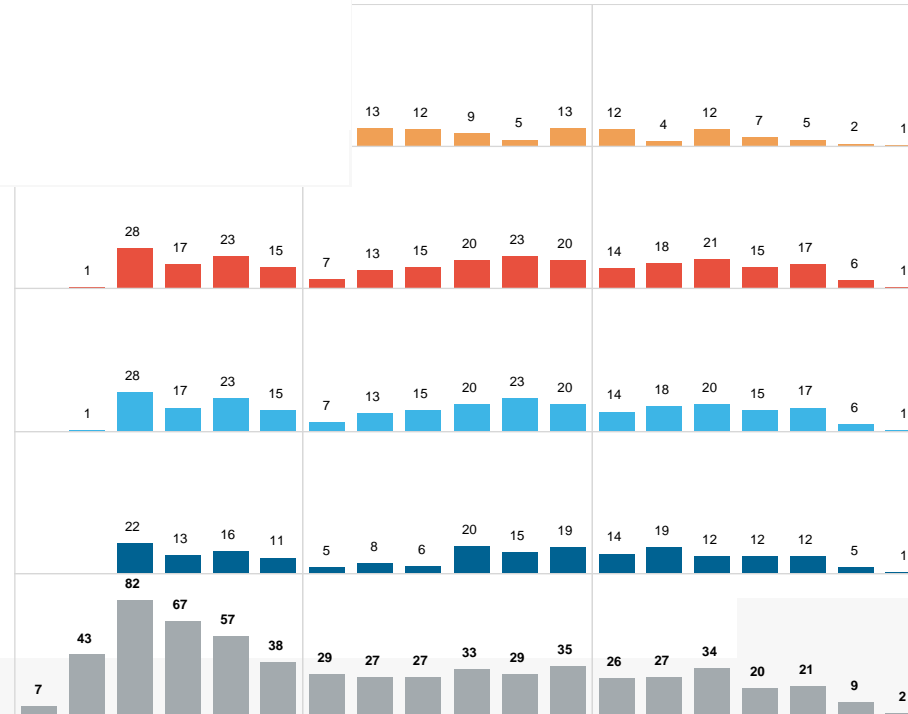

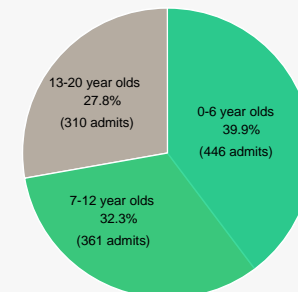
Cumulative Monthly Admits/Authorizations to Autism Spectrum Disorder Services

Total Admits by Age Group Obtained for Each Age

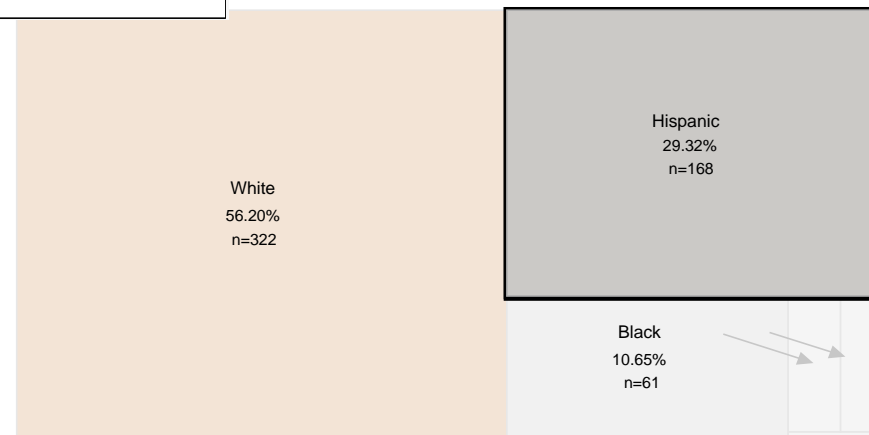

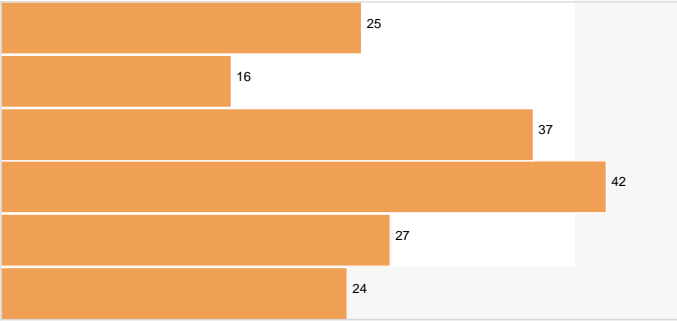

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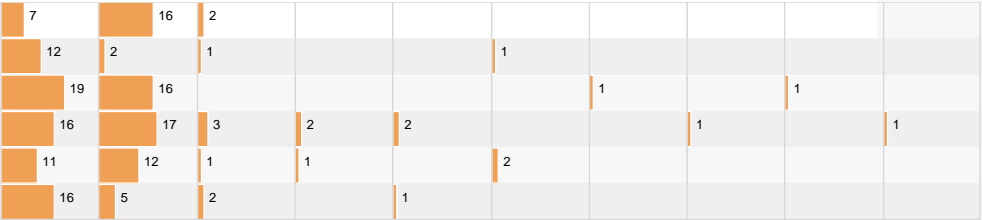


Beacon's Care Coordinators and Peer Specialists are working with a total of **171 youth** and families to connect them with ASD services.

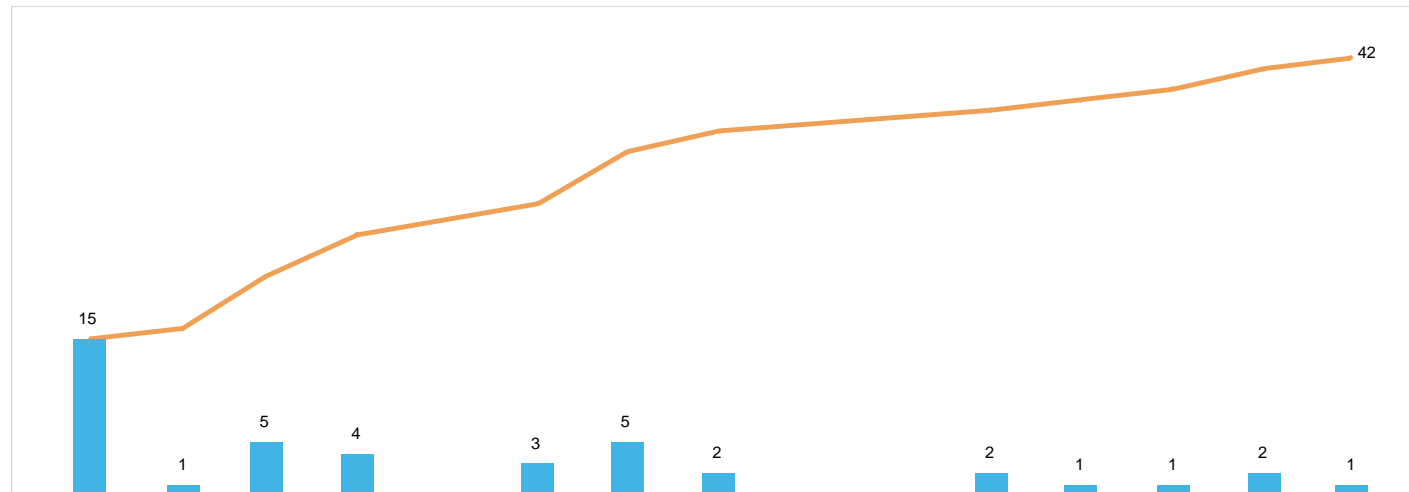

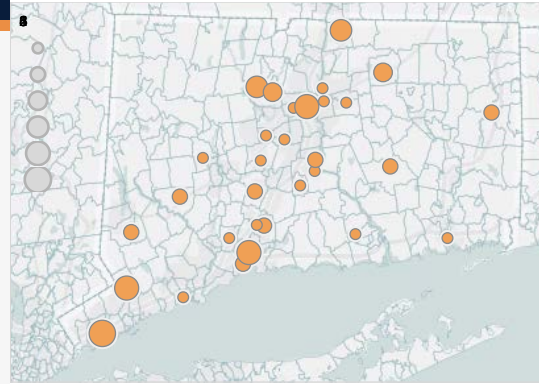

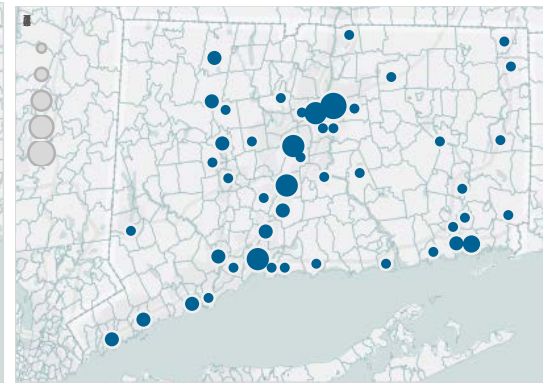
Cumulative ASD Practice Enrollment
Each practice may include multiple practitioners or be a single individual



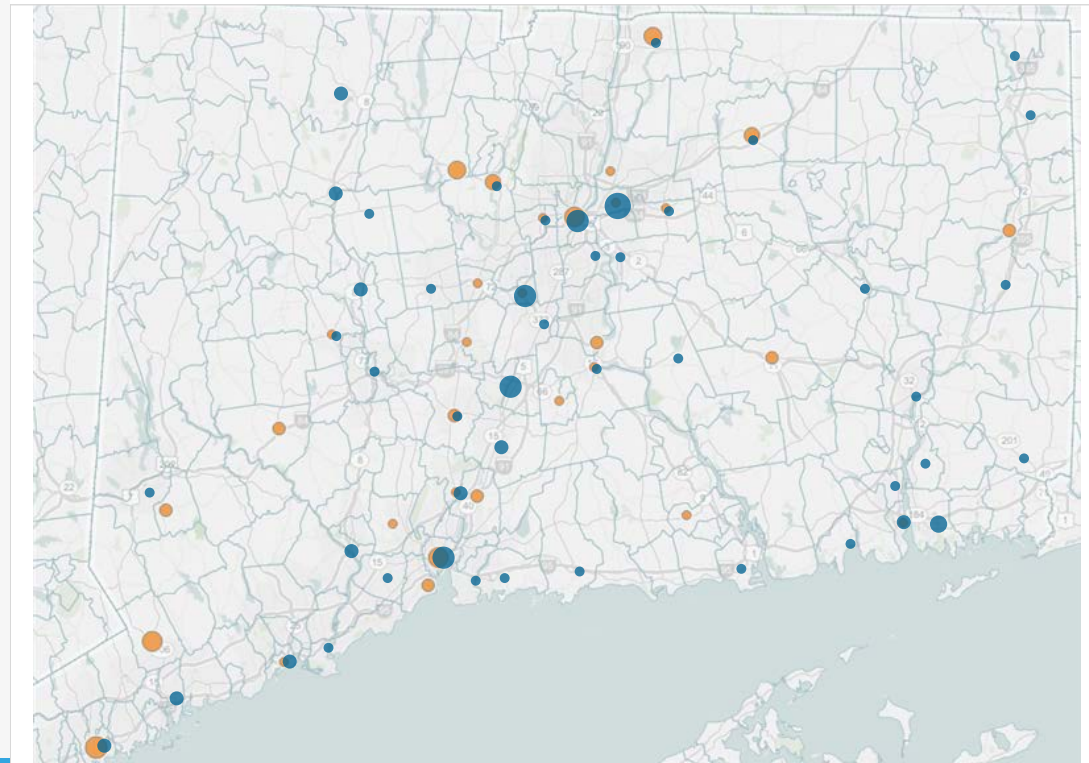
Provider Locations Individual providers by town

Strategies to Increase ASD Network Adequacy

- Survey to the Medicaid Provider Network
- Check-in with the Autism Advisory Council in June
- Connection with Early Intervention/Birth to Three Providers in June
- Regional Applied Behavioral Association (ABA) Conferences (Massachusetts-May 6th/New York Oct. 26th/27th)
- Review the DDS Autism Services Provider List again
- Creation and hosting: Increasing Cash Flow through Medicaid Behavioral Services
- Distribution of job postings, opportunities through MA ABA, CT ABA and the ASD Provider Network
- Connection with University of St. Joseph's, Sacred Heart, Fairfield U, UCONN, Quinnipiac, and other schools' Career Development and Internship Offices linking Behavioral/Human Services undergrad/grad students with providers for behavioral technician positions
