The following Level of Care Guidelines have been developed and reviewed by the Clinical Management Committee of the CTBHP Oversight Council:

- Comprehensive Diagnostic Evaluation
- Behavior Assessment
- Treatment Plan Development
- Program Book Development
- Treatment Services
- Observation and Direction

According to the statutory language regarding the development of the CTBHP there must be level of care guidelines associated with all services provided under the CTBHP. For an idea of what the current level of care guidelines look like, please refer to the CTBHP website (ctbhp.com) and go to "For Providers" then click on the "Level of Care Guidelines" link.

All Level of Care Guidelines are developed or revised under the auspices of the Clinical Management Committee (CMC). Once the guidelines have been completed by the CMC, they are presented to and reviewed by the Operations Subcommittee of the CTBHP Oversight Council. Typically, any questions that providers and/or consumers might have about the guidelines are addressed there and recommendations can be made for revisions. Once the guidelines are approved by the Operations Subcommittee, the subcommittee co-chairs report to the CTBHP Oversight Council and recommend approval.

It is very important that those who provide the services being discussed are present at the Operations subcommittee so that there is opportunity for review and discussion.
