Enhanced Care Clinic Overview

- Enhanced Care Clinics (ECCs) provide routine outpatient services to CT BHP members
- Initiative began in 2006 with RFA.
- From 2006 to present there are 34 ECCs with approximately 71 secondary sites across CT
 - 15 Child only ECCs
 - 5 Adult only ECCs
 - 14 Lifespan ECCs



ECC Requirements

ECCs receive higher fees in return for meeting the following requirements:

- Access: timely access, assess barriers to access, thorough screening and triage
- Collaboration and Coordination with Primary Care
- Screening, assessment & treatment of cooccurring mental health and substance use disorders
- Future requirements: Welcoming and Engagement; Evidence-Based Practice; Cultural Competence
