ACCESS Mental Health

- Embedded within PA 13-3 SB 1160
- "An Act Concerning Gun Violence Prevention and Children's Safety"
- \$1.8 million allocated for regional psychiatric consultation for primary care providers who serve children
- ValueOptions to administer program
- RFP for Psychiatric Consultation HUBS is underway

ACCESS – MH (cont.)

GOALS:

- 1. to educate pediatric providers on psychiatric disorders of childhood
- 2. to provide consultation around prescribing/managing psychotropic medications
- 3. to inform pediatric practices about local community resources available to help children/families with behavioral health concerns
- 4. to provide or arrange for emergency face-to-face assessment and connect-to-care when necessary

CONNECT Ct Network of Care Transformation

- One year, \$400K SAMHSA grant designed to support expansion of current System of Care by developing a strategic plan that integrates activities and focus of various child-caring sectors on a regional level
- Based on System of care principals

(Family driven, child centered, culturally competent)

CONNECT (cont.)

- Goal is to develop a strategic plan to organize and coordinate activities between various child caring sectors; juvenile justice, early childhood, child welfare, education within a designated region to assist families in obtaining help across systems
- Project also call for an integrated data set across systems

Children's MH Implementation Plan PA 13-178

- Legislatively driven mandate to create a comprehensive mental health plan addressing the needs of *all* children related to prevention, early intervention, and treatment
- Governor endorsed, DCF led initiative with support from CHDI and CT Health Foundation
- Extensive community outreach/listening forums underway

13-178 (cont.)

- Status report to legislature in April, 2014
- Full report due October, 2014
- Opportunity to review/incorporate findings from previous mental health plans, initiatives combined with immediate public input
- Opportunity to reinforce/enact planning activities embedded within the CONNECT grant

SFY 13-14 Allocations

- \$3.5 million for Additional Trauma informed services
 - \$1 million for Modular Approach to Therapy for Children with Anxiety, Depression, Tauma or Conduct Problems (MATCH-ADCP)
 - \$1 million for statewide expansion of Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy
 - \$1 million for New Haven Trauma Coalition
 - \$500K for Bridgeport Cognitive Behavioral Intervention for Trauma in Schools (CBITS)

Allocations (cont.)

- \$2 million for MST Expansion
 - MST-Problem Sexual Behavior (\$275K)
 - MST- Building Stronger Families (\$1.8 mill)

\$1.2 Million for Statewide Expansion of CBITS

Proposed Budget Option SFY 2014-2015

 \$2 million for additional community based services tied to an anticipated \$5.4 million reduction in Congregate Care expenditures
