CT Behavioral Health Partnership Oversight Council (BHPOC) Committee Leadership Selection Protocol Draft 1.1

The leadership of the four standing committees of the BHPOC (Coordination of Care; Adult Quality, Access, and Policy; Child and Adolescent Quality, Access, and Policy; and Operations) is typically composed of co-chairs or tri-chairs, at least one of whom must be a member of the BHPOC. All such chairs are appointed by the Executive Committee from among the Council membership and in their capacity as appointed committee chairs serve on the BHPOC Executive Committee. These committee chairs represent the Council and the Executive Committee in the leadership of the committees to which they are appointed and are responsible to report back to the Council and its Executive Committee about the activities of their committees. They serve as committee chairs coterminous with their BHPOC membership. Additional chairs may be elected selected by the membershipattendees of the committee meetings for appointment by the BHPOC Executive Committee.; though a At no time may a committee have more than three chairs, except in the case of a joint committee. All committee chairs are appointed to fill a vacancy or as otherwise indicated and are reappointed on a biennial basis in the first quarter of even-numbered years. There is no limit to the number of reappointments for which a committee chair is eligible.
