Covers **800,000 Connecticut citizens** (22% of the state population) who live in all 169 towns





Covers **four out of ten births**, statewide



- Covers over 70% of all nursing home residents, and also covers home and community-based services for older adults and people with disabilities
- Has increased use of preventative care by over 16%, supporting school readiness for children and work readiness and stability for adults



Has reduced per member, per month costs more than any other state in the country

> *Health Affairs'* June 2017 issue reported that **Connecticut's Medicaid program led the nation in controlling cost trends on a per enrollee basis.**

 Is a lean, efficient self-insured model, with administrative costs of only 3.2%



- Receives the largest share of federal funding of any Connecticut program
 almost 60% of Medicaid and 88% of CHIP is federally funded
- → Is a good investment in the future of people, and represents the lowest share of the state budget of all New England states (23% of state budget)





Has **decreased hospital admissions** by over 16%

Represents almost **20% of all health spending in the state**, including commercial and self-insured
