UCC Outcomes

97.3% of children served in UCCs returned to their homes and communities

51.3% of families said they would have gone to the ED if not for the UCC

Referrals from UCC to other services

Of all *referrals* made:

- 47% outpatient services
- 14% psychiatric provider for medication
- 9% Intensive in-home services
- 8% intensive outpatient services
- 7% other community-based services
