Intensive Care Management (ICM) Healthy Beginnings Program

- Healthy Beginnings is a voluntary program designed to specifically support HUSKY Health members who are pregnant, recently delivered, or had a baby who spent time in the NICU after birth
- Healthy Beginnings staff work with individuals by providing person-centered pregnancy, postpartum, well newborn, and/or NICU education via:
 - Phone calls and videoconferences
 - Face-to-face meetings (when permitted) in the home, provider's office, community setting, or shelter
 - Educational mailings and email, virtual learning collaboratives
- This program utilizes a proactive model that focuses on minimizing the risk of pregnancy-related complications, which includes education using evidence-based tools on:
 - Interventions to reduce risk of complications
 - Preventive care/routine screenings
 - Reducing risk-taking behavior





Member Identification and Outreach

- Welcome calls and Health Risk Questionnaires for newly enrolled HUSKY Health members
- State and Community Agencies (DSS, DCF, WIC)
 - Daily Eligibility file Newly enrolled members on HUSKY A
 - Referral for members with HB ICM needs
- Hospital discharge planning and ED utilization
- CHNCT Utilization Management (UM), Member Engagement (ME)
 - UM delivery notifications and post-partum re-admission
 - ME following inquiries related to benefits, etc.
- Data Analytics/Predictive Modeling
- Member self-referral or call to Nurses Help Line or Crisis Queue
- Provider referrals, including OBP4P
- Other ASOs (CT BHP, CTDHP, NEMT)

Background on COVID-19 Initiatives

- HUSKY Health members were disproportionately affected by COVID-19 as compared to the general population in Connecticut (27% of cases statewide while HUSKY Health represents only about 20-21% of the population)
- Although the largest number of members affected by COVID-19 were White/Caucasian/Non-Hispanics, Black/African American/Non-Hispanics and Hispanic members were affected in numbers that are higher than their incidence in the population of Connecticut
- COVID-19 significantly affected members' willingness to get care, both hospital and preventive care, disproportionately
- To respond to this, Community Health Network of Connecticut, Inc.[®] (CHNCT) implemented the following strategies:
 - Training and enhanced protocols for member support, including the 24/7 Nurse Help Line
 - Specialized Intensive Care Management
 - Promotion of resources and testing sites



Impact of COVID-19 on HUSKY Health Members

- Since March of 2020, CHNCT has been monitoring the impact of COVID-19 on HUSKY Health members
- Through September of 2020, 16,826 HUSKY Health members were diagnosed with COVID-19
- The average age of COVID-19 cases in the HUSKY Health population is 51. The most common comorbidities found in COVID-19 cases are hypertension (42%) and diabetes (25%), followed by obesity (19%) and asthma (15%). Substance use disorder was also present in 11% of these members
- Of the members with a COVID-19 diagnosis, there have been 724 hospitalizations as of September 30th
 - Black/African American/Non-Hispanics were more likely to be hospitalized with COVID-19. This population accounted for 17% of total cases, yet 25% of hospitalized members
 - White/Caucasian/Non-Hispanics accounted for the largest percentage of total cases

COVID-19/Perinatal Interventions

- Evidenced-based coaching on protection from and reducing the spread of COVID-19
- Symptoms and when to contact healthcare provider/COVID-19 hotline
- Available community resources, location of mobile testing sites
- Coaching on the importance of attending all prenatal/postpartum appointments and maintaining preventive and condition-specific care
- Importance of well baby visits and immunizations
- HUSKY Health covered benefits such as:
 - Self blood pressure measurement device
 - Double electric breast pump
- Empowering members to achieve optimal outcomes by providing member-specific culturally competent education, coaching, and support
- Increasing awareness of maternal morbidity, mortality, and health disparities, including focused interventions to improve maternal outcomes by addressing health inequities
- Perinatal Learning Group to bring expectant mothers together in an online learning environment, offered in English and Spanish
- Perinatal/breastfeeding member emails on "COVID-19, Pregnancy, & Breastfeeding," available in English and Spanish
