## Looking for free birth control?

People of all ages and all genders can get coverage for birth control, STI testing and treatment, and other services with no out-of-pocket cost with the <u>HUSKY Health Limited Benefit Family Planning Program!</u>



## You can apply as an individual if:

- You're a resident of Connecticut.
- Your household income, before taxes, is less than: or equal to:
  - \$3,430/month for a family of 1
  - \$4,635/month for a family of 2
  - \$5,841/month for a family of 3
- \$7,046/month for a family of 4
- \$8,252/month for a family of 5
- \$9,457/month for a family of 6
- You are not already enrolled in a public health coverage program (i.e. Medicaid/HUSKY).
- You're a U.S. citizen or have a qualifying immigration status.



## Here's what you can get for free:

- All FDA-approved birth control methods, including emergency contraception, IUD, implant, pills, condoms, patch, ring, Depo-Provera, tubal ligation and vasectomy.
- Annual check-up.
- STI testing/treatment and HIV testing/counseling.
- Screening for breast, cervical, and colorectal cancer.
- HPV vaccines.



## You should also know that...

 You can apply for 12 months of coverage by going to <u>connect.ct.gov/access</u> and checking "Family Planning" at the bottom of the "What Kind of Help Are You Applying For? page.

 You can apply if you have private insurance you don't want to, or can't, use because it doesn't cover birth control or you have privacy or cost concerns.
