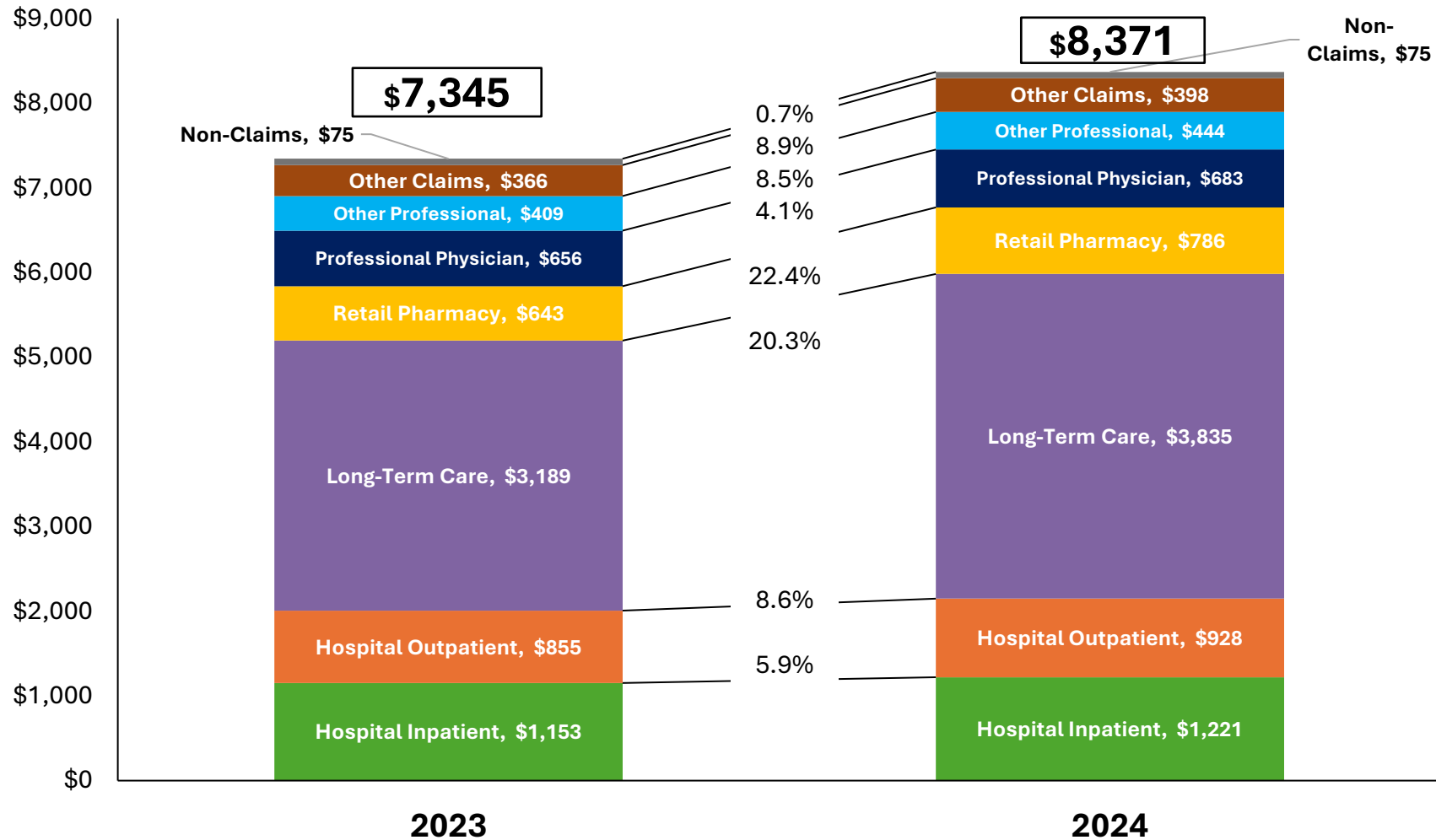
Per Capita Spending Growth and Total Spending, Statewide and by Market

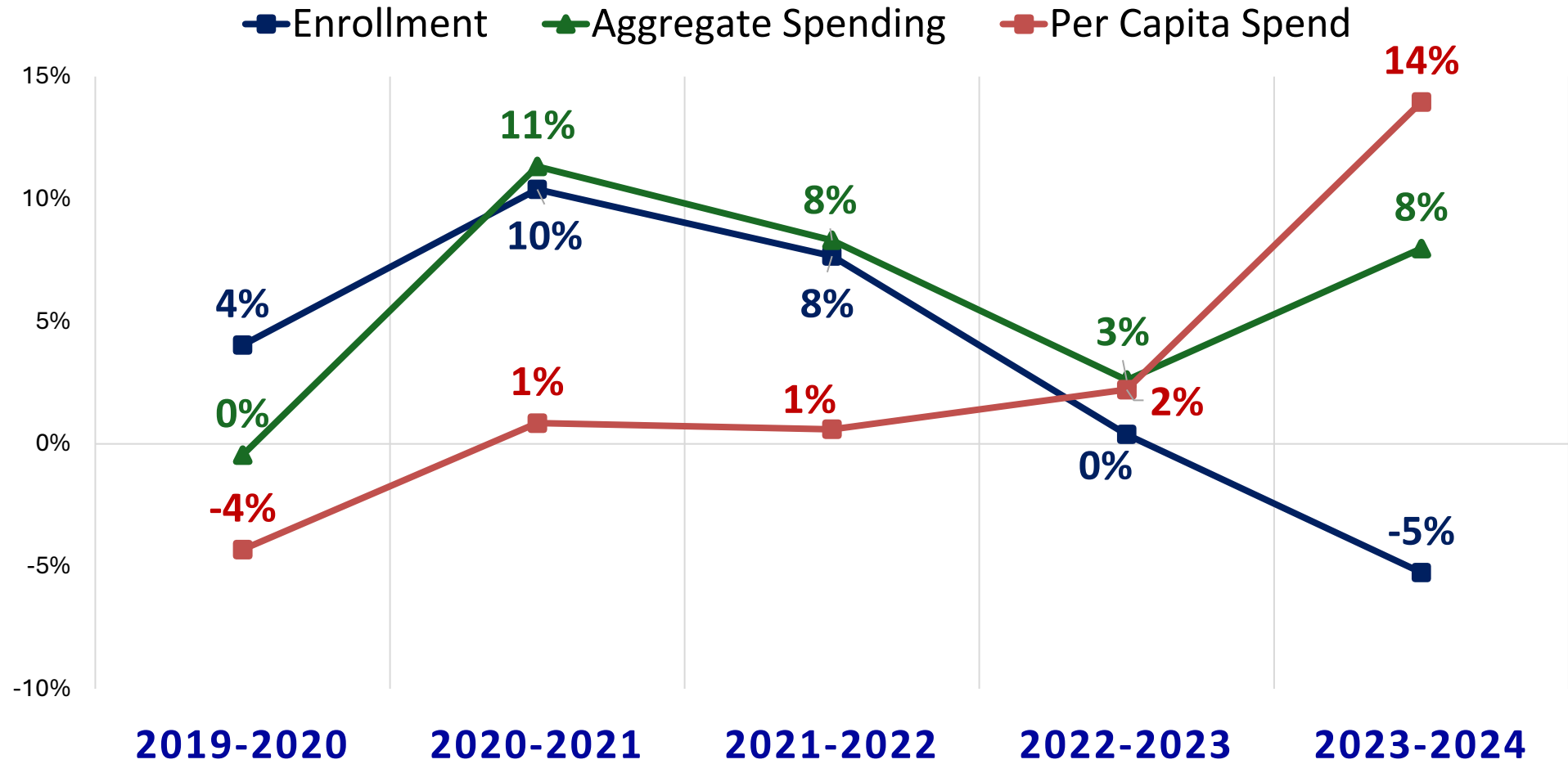
Medicaid Per Capita TME by Service Category

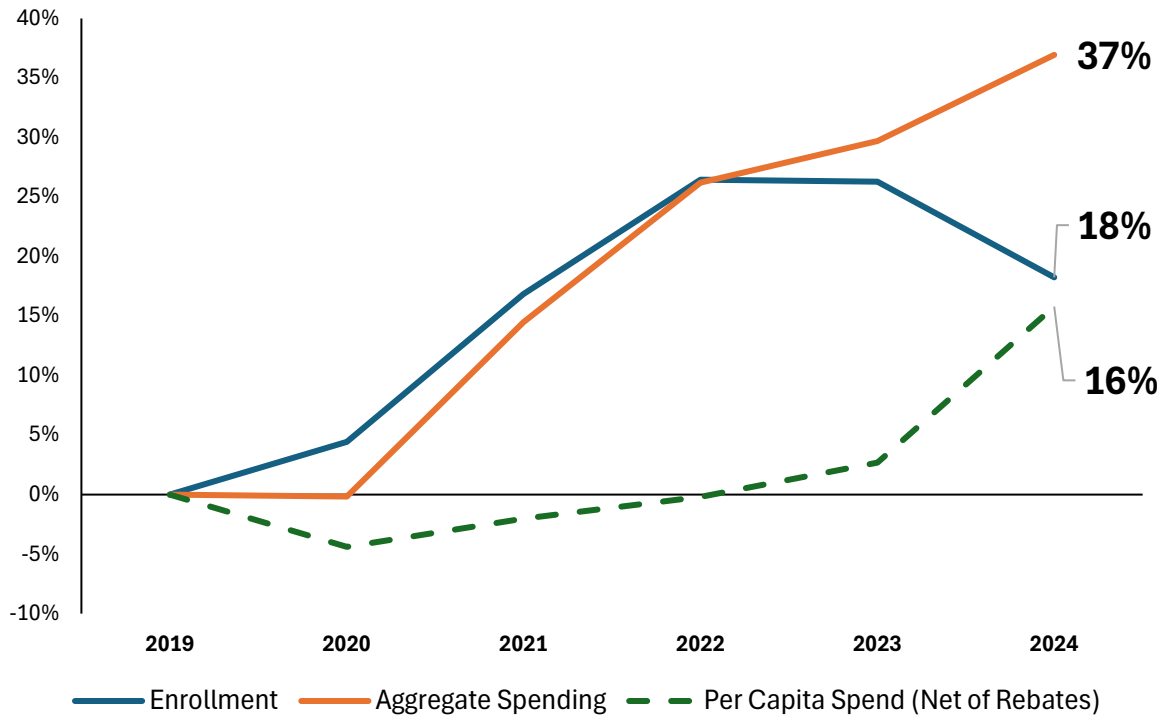
Medicaid Year over Year Annual Trends in Enrollment and Spending (2019-2024)



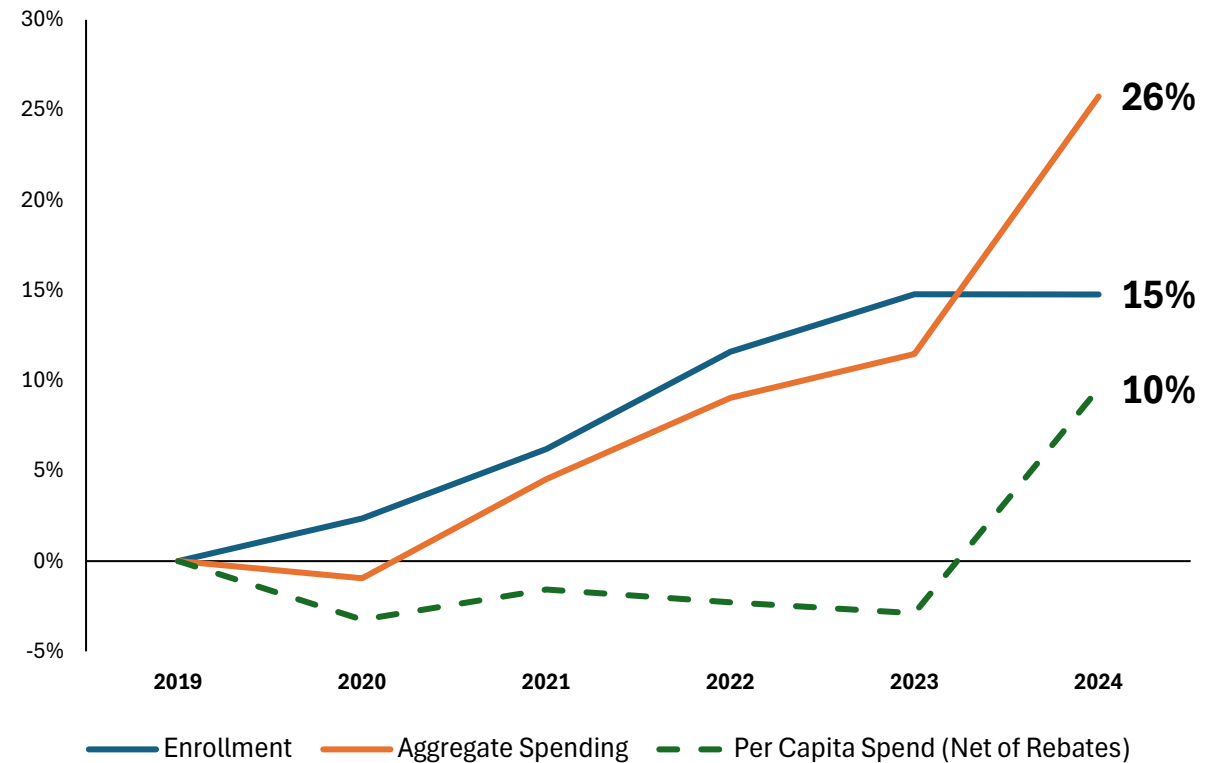

Medicaid Trends in Enrollment and Spending, Dually-Eligible

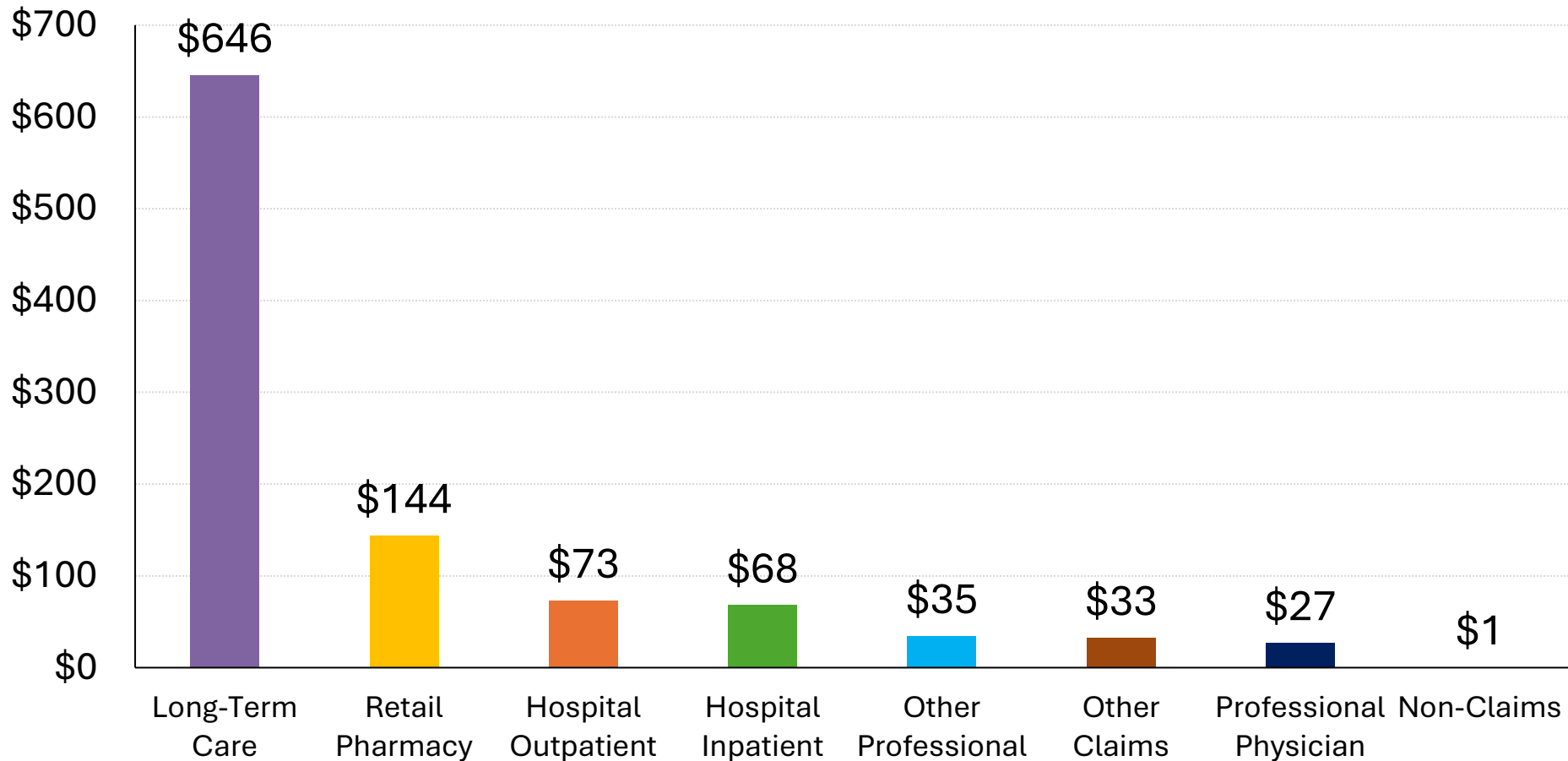
Cumulative Trend in Enrollment (Medicaid, *Excludes* Dually- Eligible)
