Project Overview

- The State of Connecticut Department of Social Services (The Department) commissioned GreatBlue Research to conduct the 2021 PCMH+ Person-Centered Primary Care Measure (PCPCM) Survey with Provider Services utilizing telephonic and digital survey methodologies from September 9, 2021 to December 6, 2021. The sample universe consisted of adults and children enrolled in the HUSKY Health Program who were contacted in efforts to complete 5,838 surveys.
- The 2021 PCMH+ PCPCM Member Survey with Provider Services included the following areas of investigation:
 - PCMH+ Member satisfaction with Primary Care experience
 - Health care over the last 12 months
 - Member demographic information
- The primary goals of the research were to build an understanding of member opinions and perceptions as they pertain to care received from their Primary Care Provider, and enable Community Health Network of CT, Inc. (“CHNCT”) to identify near-term opportunities for improvement of Member Satisfaction with Provider Services.
- GreatBlue Research utilized the Person-Centered Primary Care Measure, or PCPCM, developed by the Larry A. Green Center, in order to achieve these goals. The PCPCM is a survey of primary care quality that focuses on the patient’s access to care, relationship with the physician, and ability to reach health outcome goals.
- Upon receipt of the survey instrument and a random sample list of members, GreatBlue call center and senior staff completed all remaining facets of the 2021 PCMH+ PCPCM Member Satisfaction Survey with Provider Services. These tasks included the following: survey programming, researcher training, survey pre-testing, full-scale fielding (telephone calls and digital collection), coding, data entry, editing, validation, verification, computer analysis, analysis and report writing.

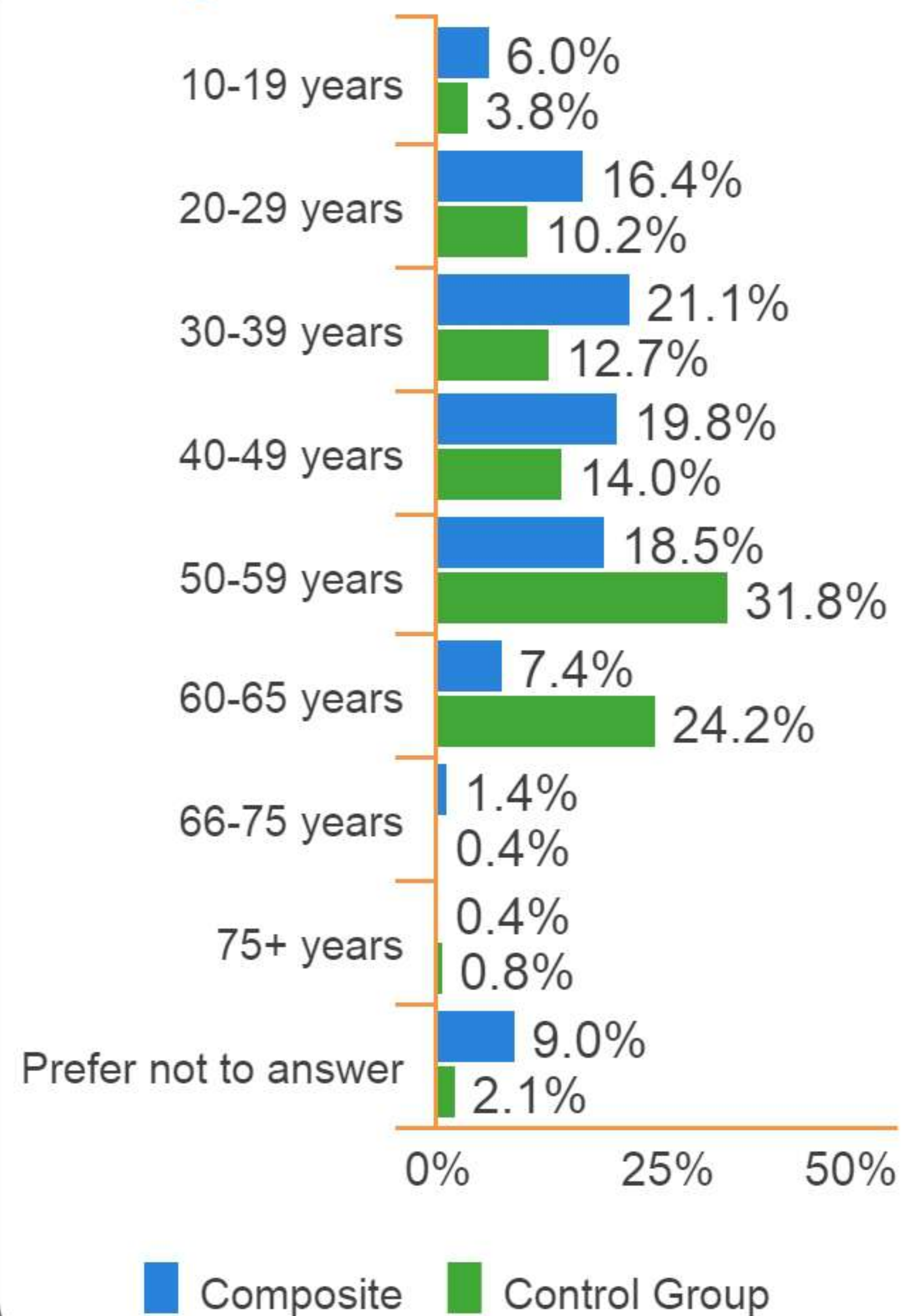

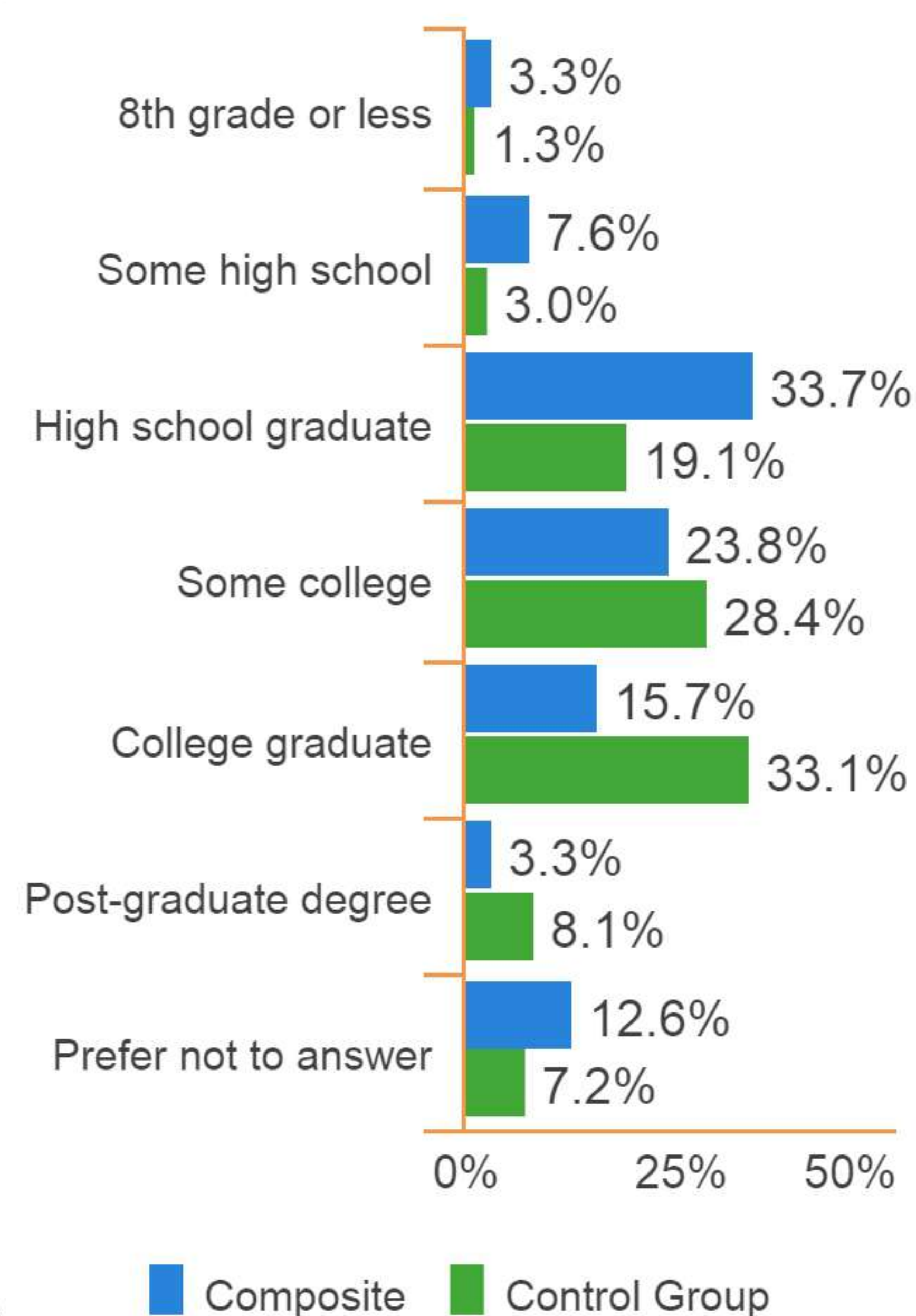

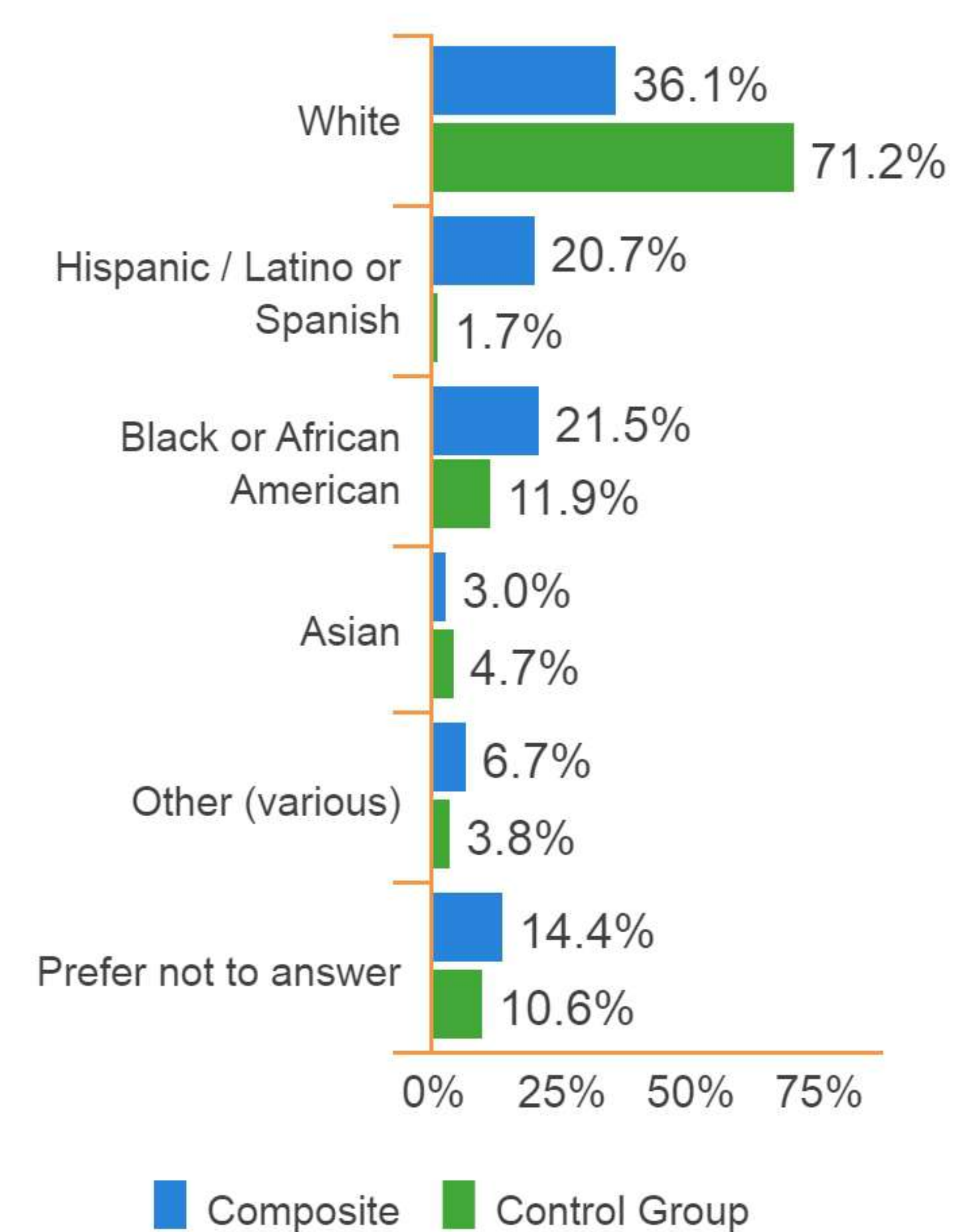

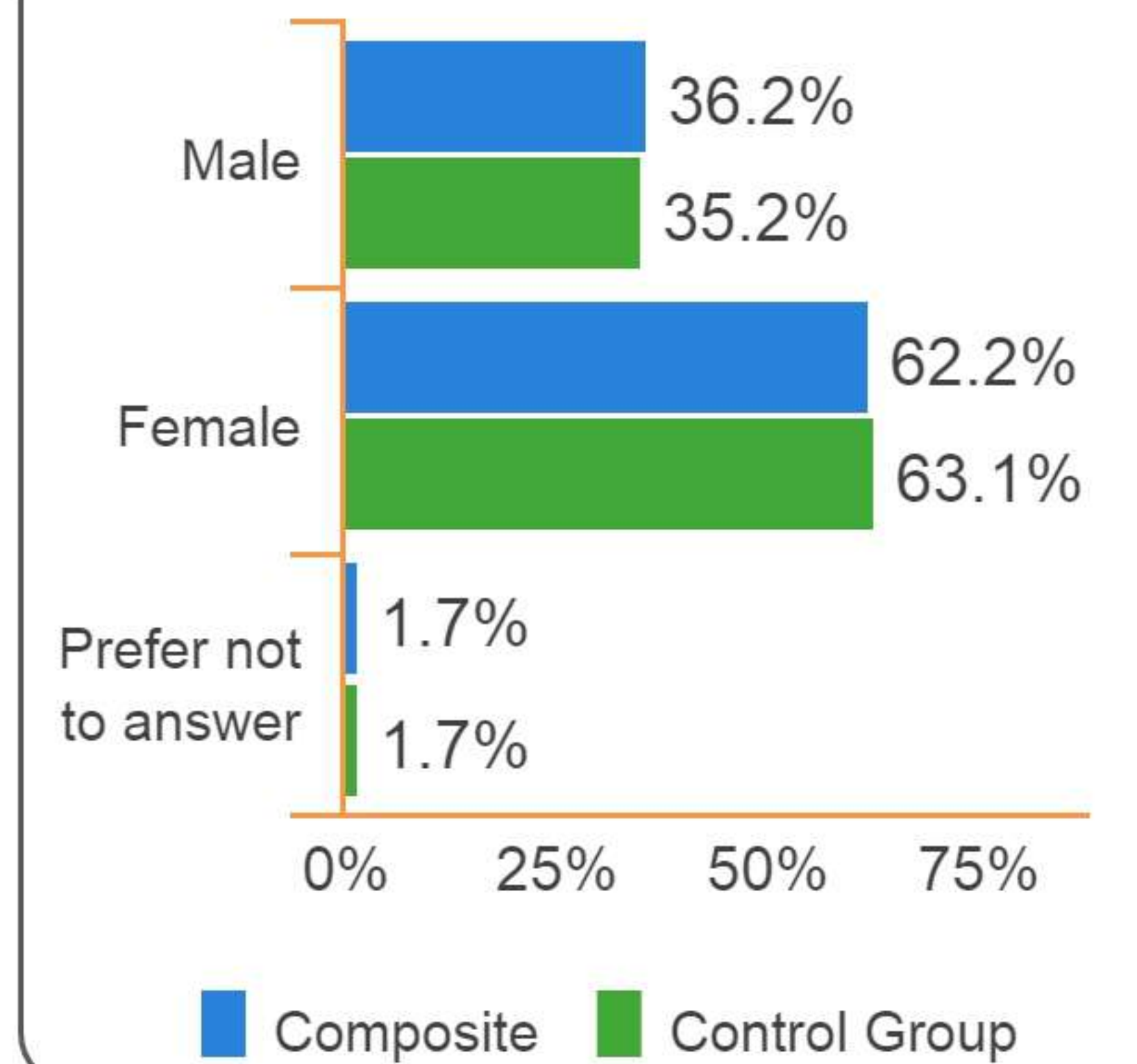

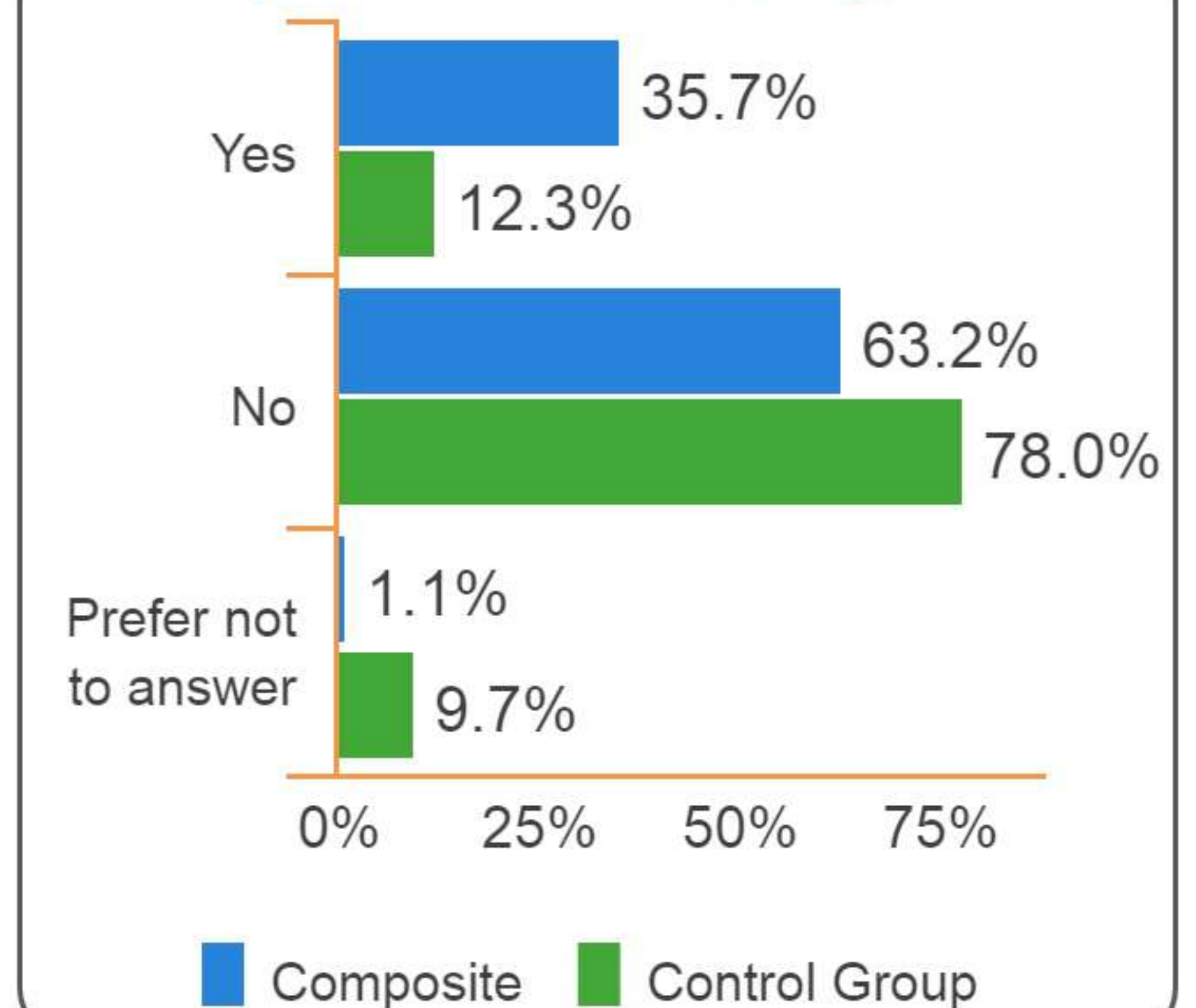

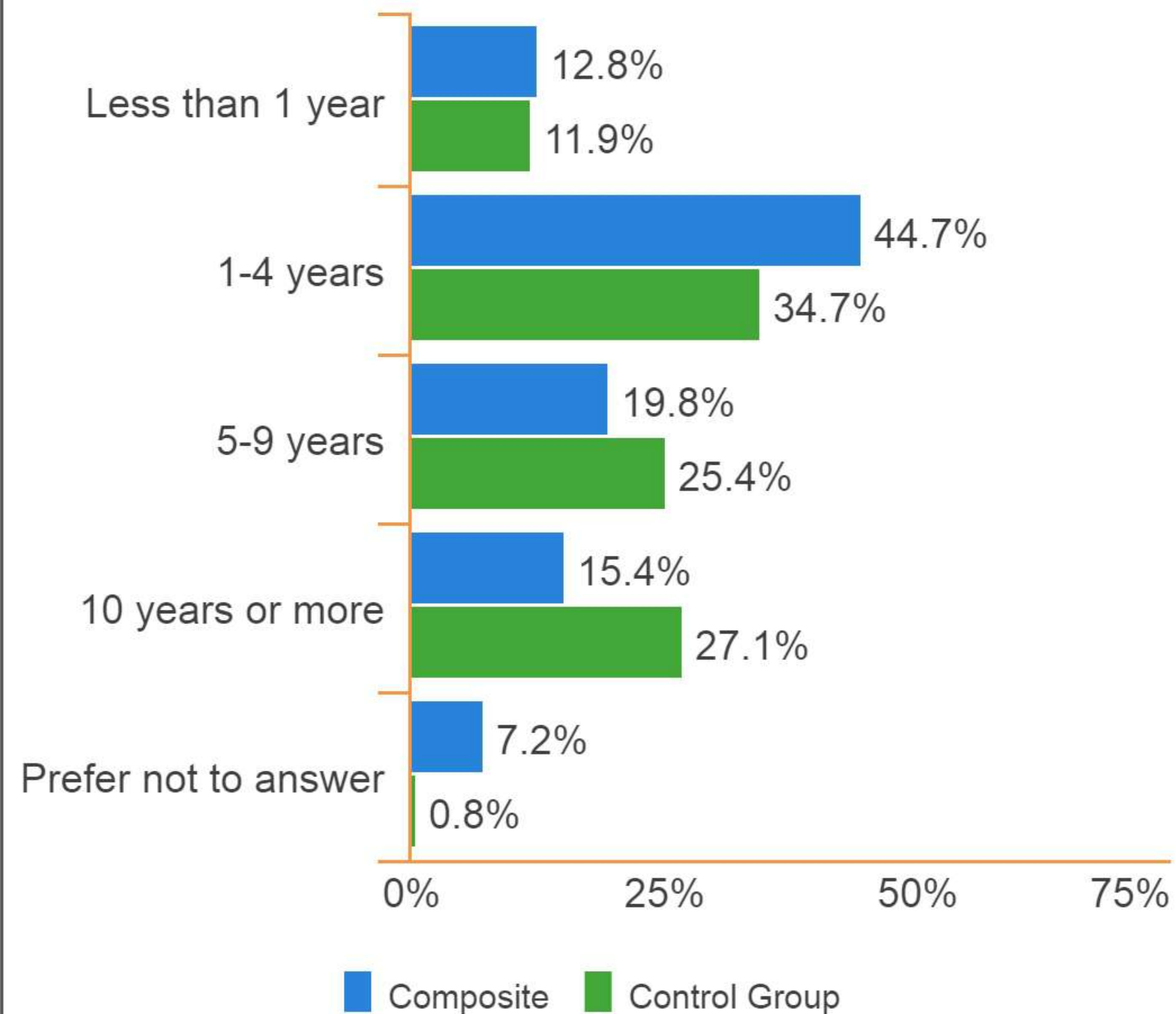

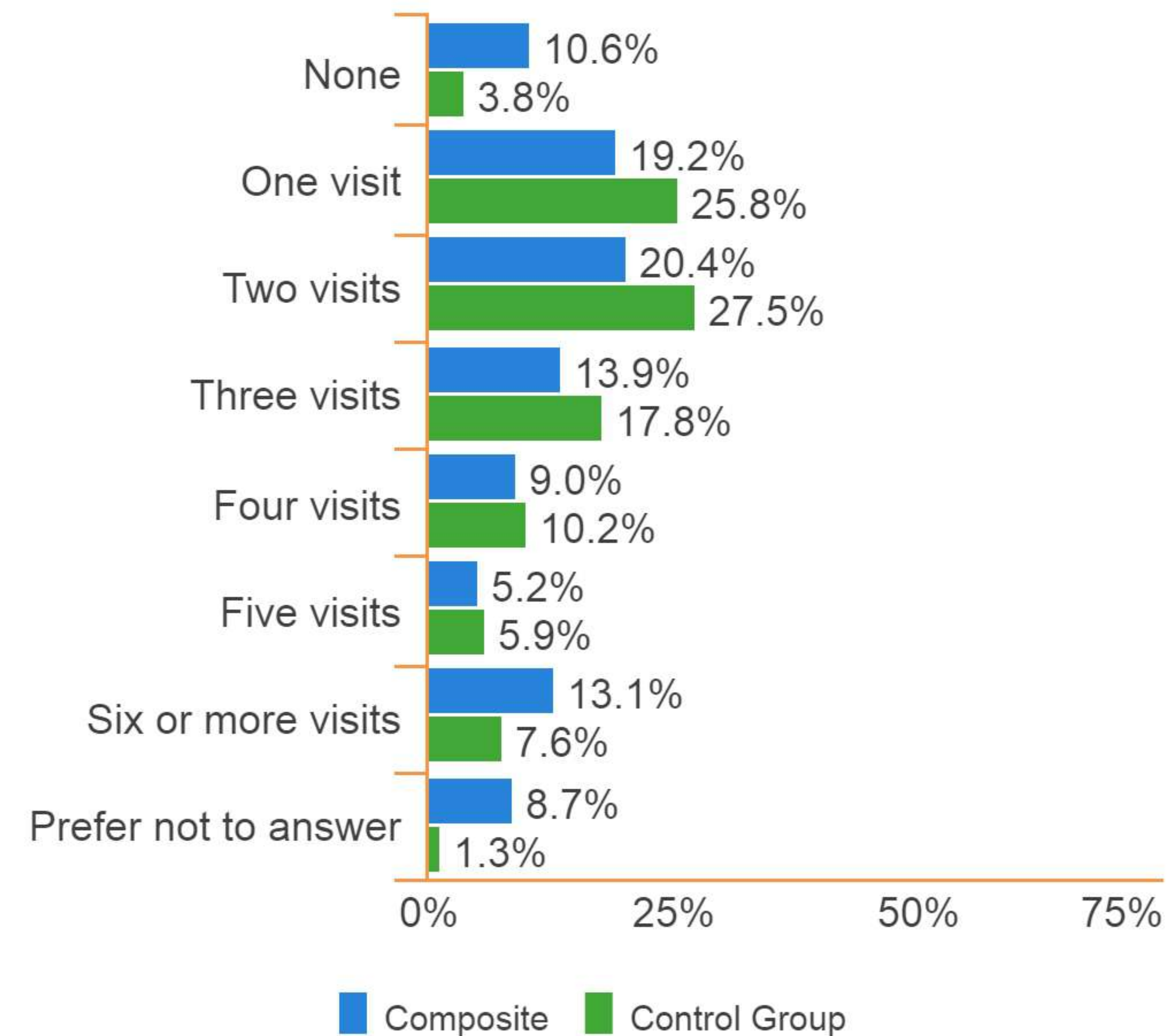

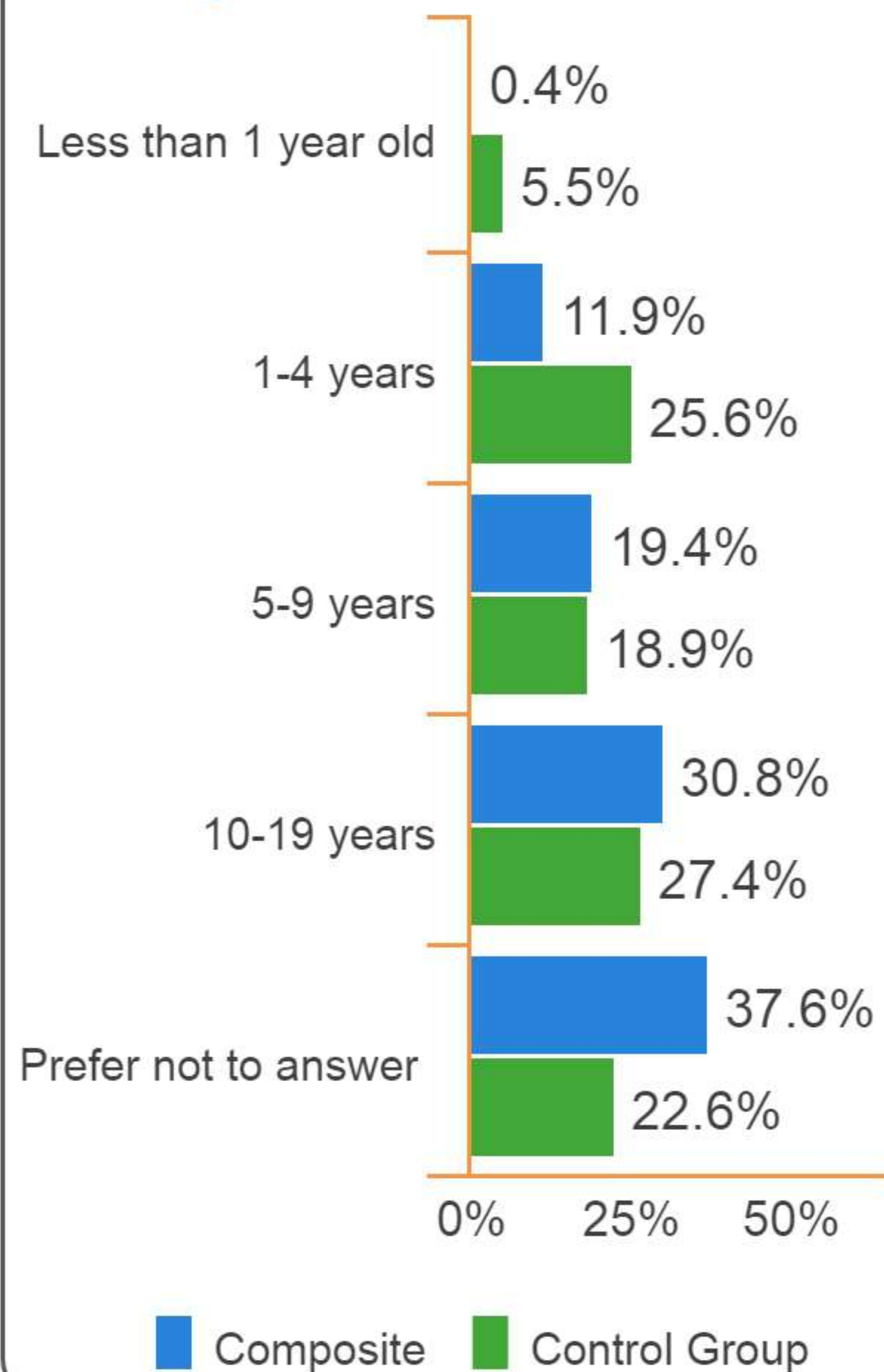

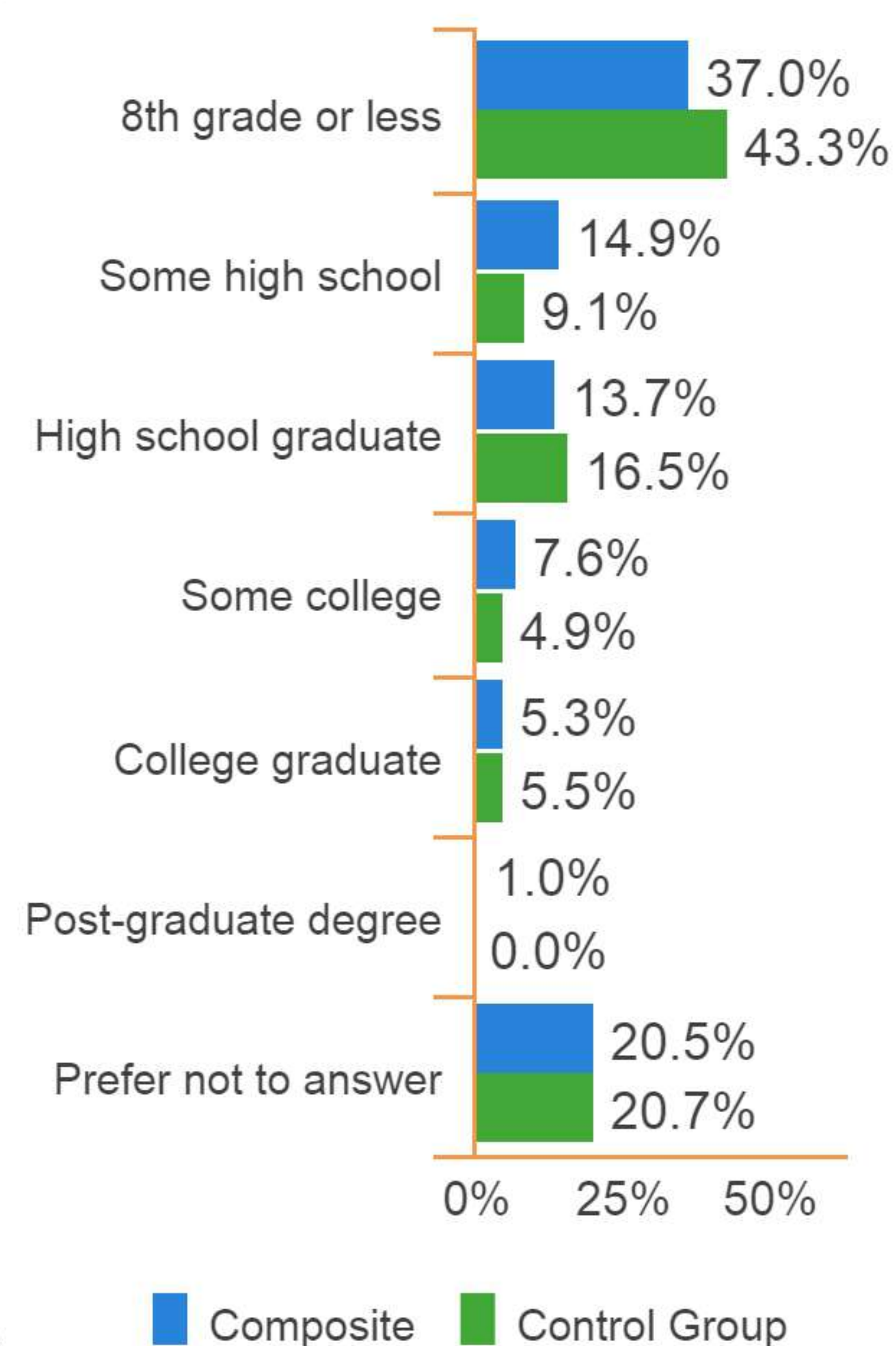

Respondent Demographics - Child

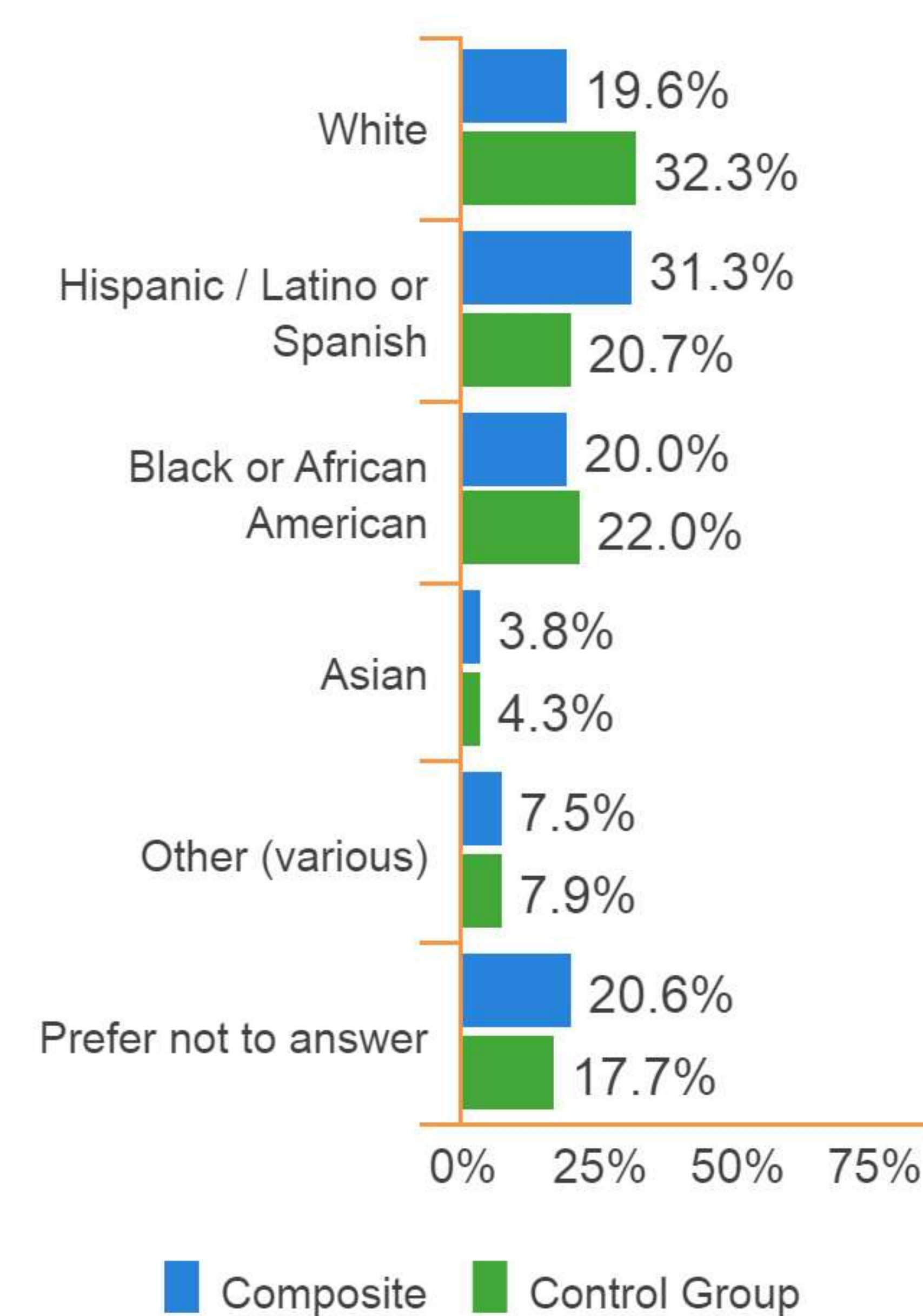

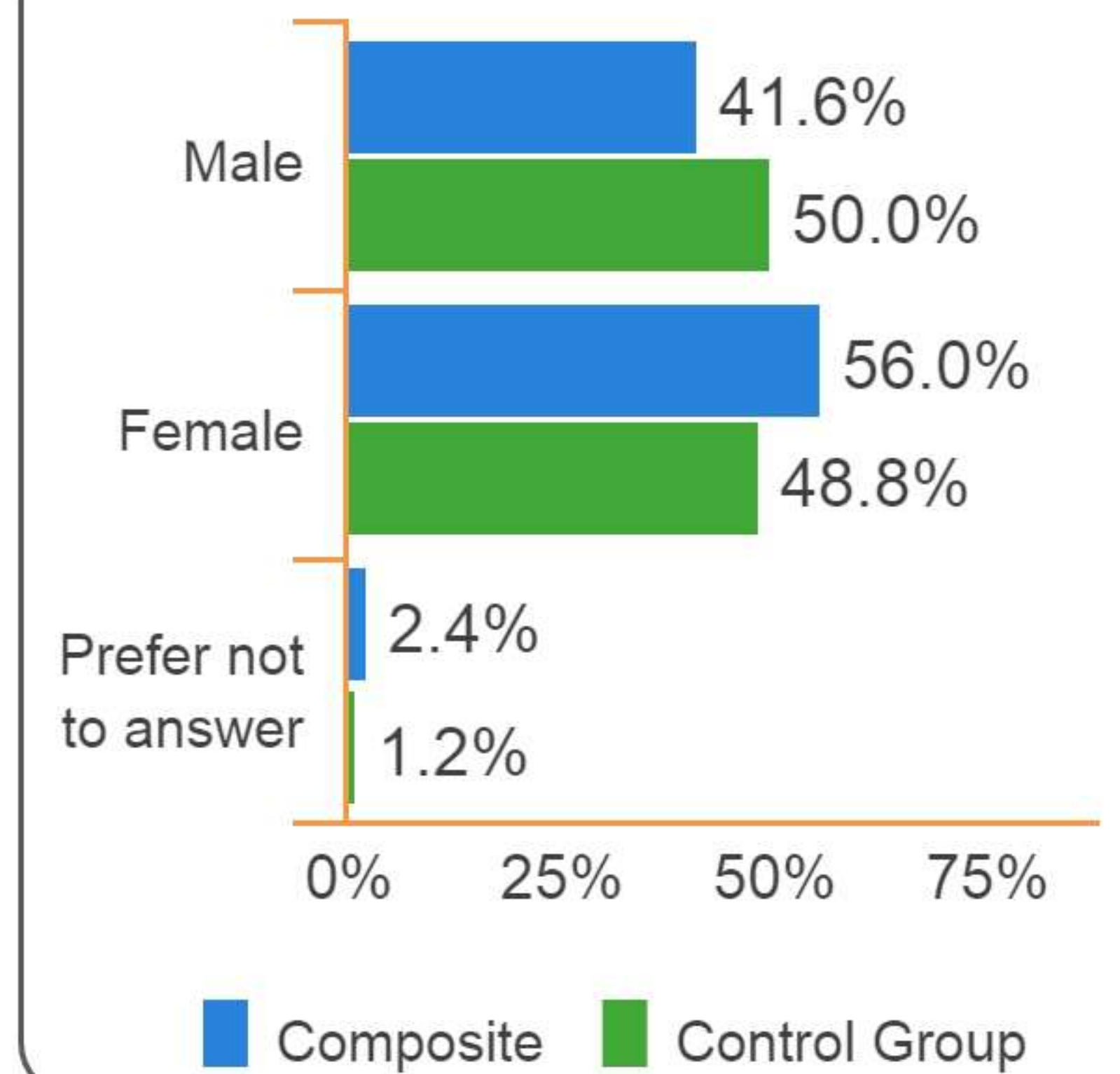

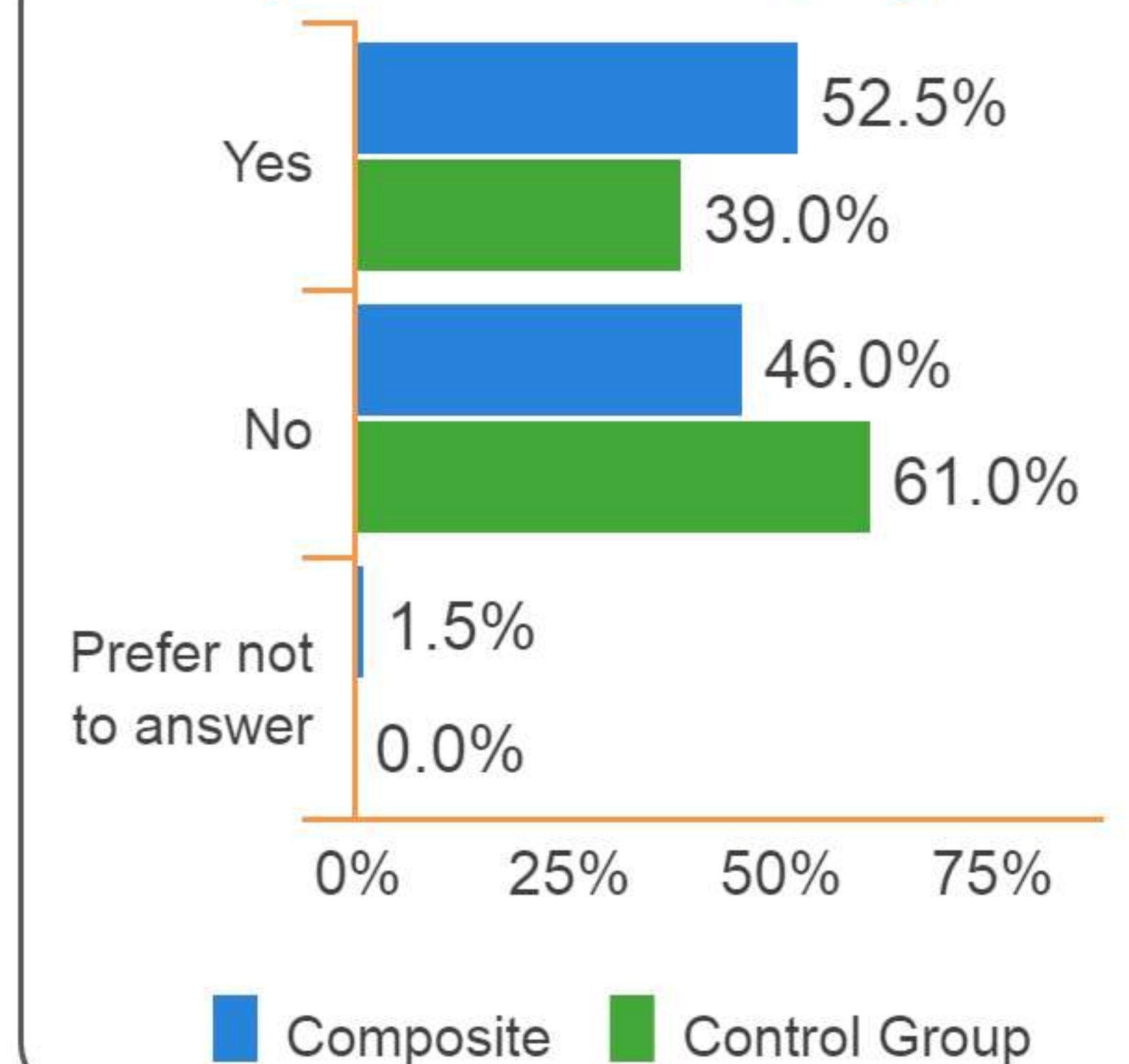

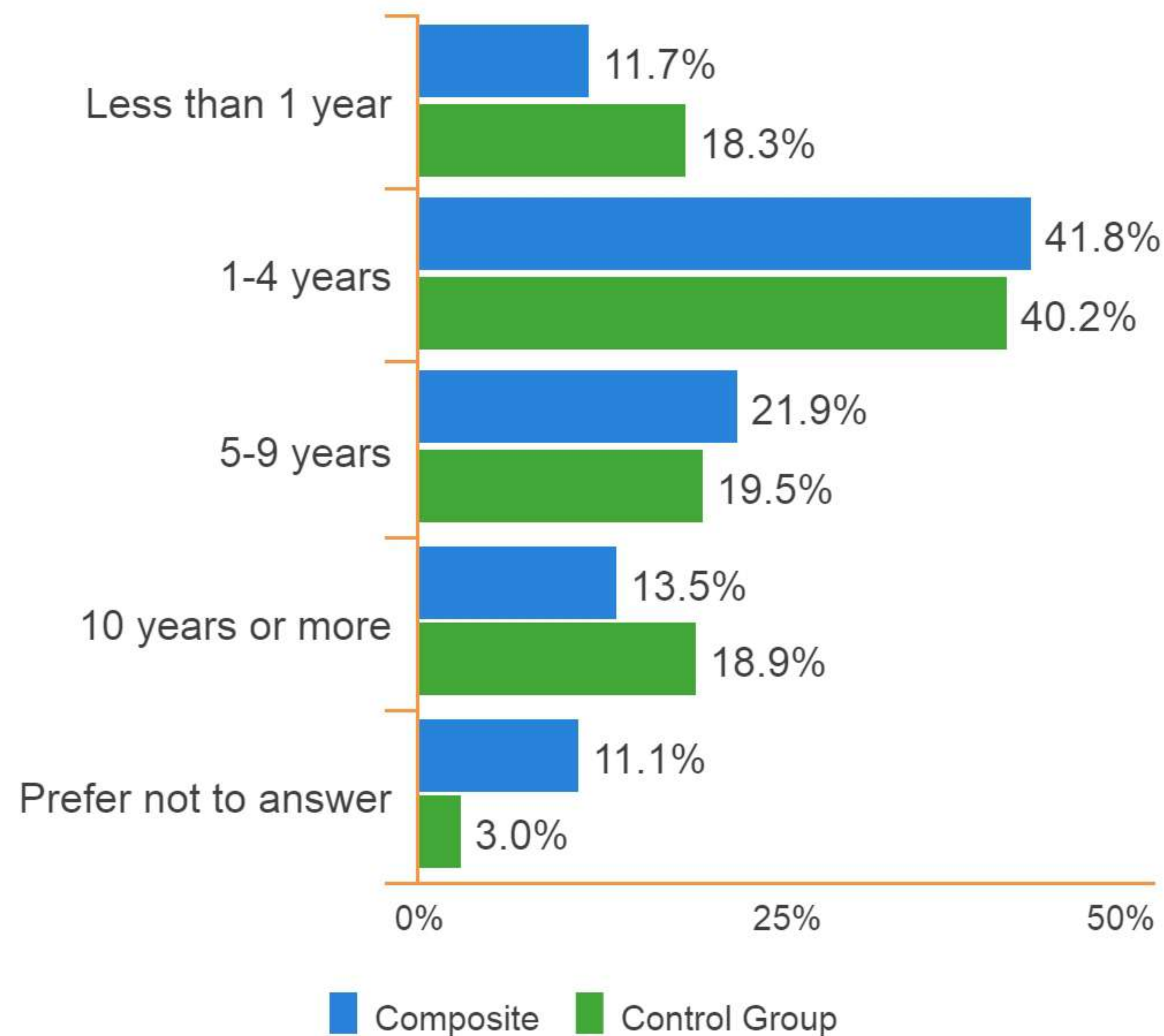


Hispanic/Latino Origin

Number of Doctor Visits in Past Year

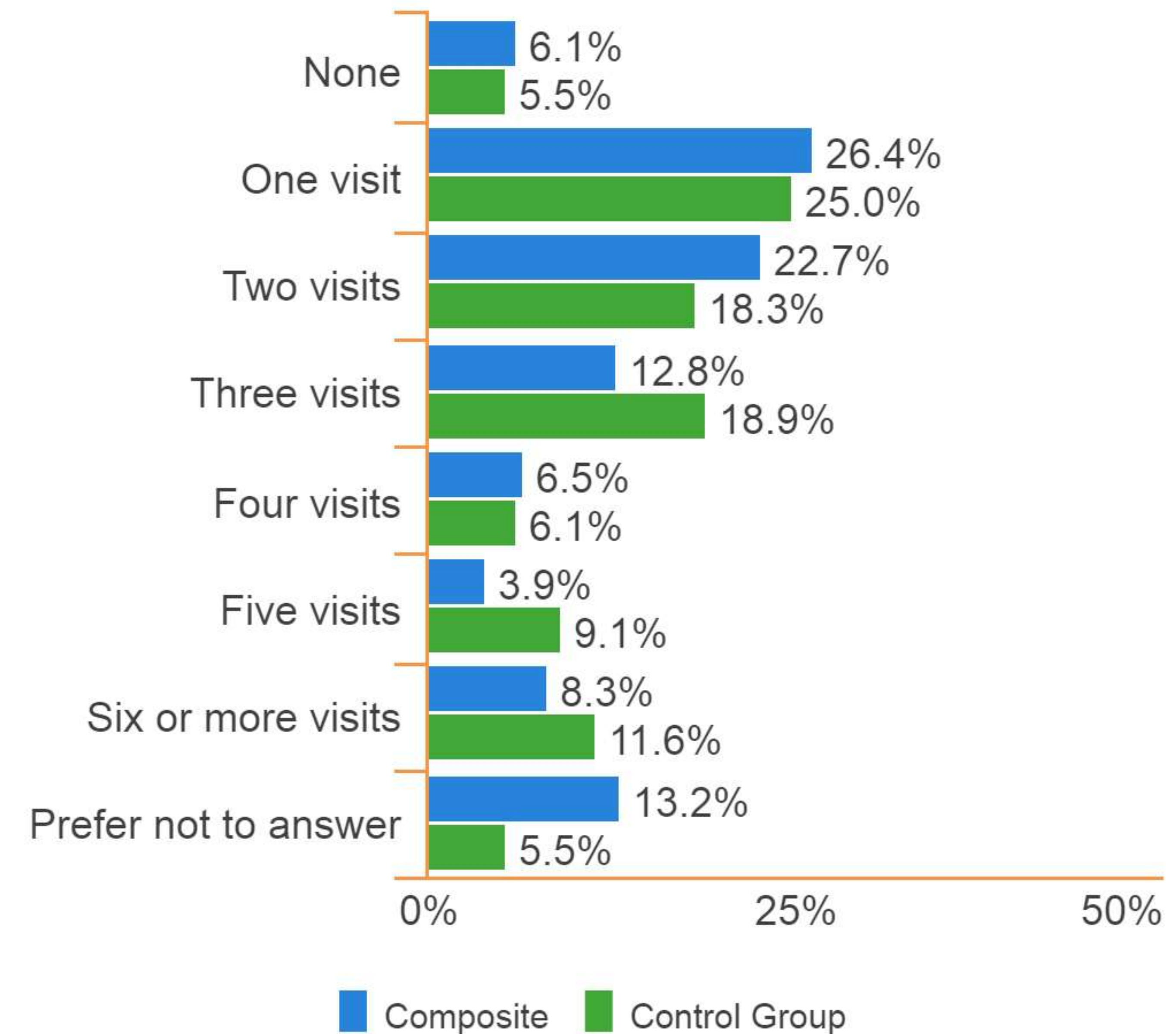

Key Study Findings - Adult

- Adult survey respondents in the composite group provided higher ratings for seven (7) of eleven (11) characteristics rated in the PCPCM survey as compared to adults in the control group.
- Among the adult composite group, the average score across all eleven (11) characteristics was 81.8%, while the average score among adult control group respondents was 79.2%.
- Adult composite survey respondents provided the highest ratings for “my practice is able to provide most of my care” (89.0%) and “in caring for me, my doctor considers all factors that affect my health” (89.0%), while the lowest rated characteristic was “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (64.6%).
- Adult control group survey respondents provided the highest rating for “my practice makes it easy for me to get care” (91.1%), while the lowest rated characteristic was “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (55.1%).
- The largest increase in scores for the adult composite group over the adult control group was recorded for “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (64.6% versus 55.1%), while the largest increase in scores for the adult control group over the adult composite group was recorded for “my practice makes it easy for me to get care” (91.1% versus 88.3%).
- Among adult composite survey respondents, the provider office receiving the highest average score across all eleven (11) characteristics was CCMC Advanced Network (89.7%), while the lowest average score was recorded for United Community and Family Services (76.9%).

Key Study Findings - Adult

- Adult composite survey respondents ages 75+ (97.5%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents ages 40-49 provided the lowest average rating (78.3%).
- Men in the adult composite survey (83.9%) provided a higher average rating as compared to women (80.5%).
- Asian respondents in the adult composite survey (87.9%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents characterizing themselves as an “other” ethnicity provided the lowest average rating (79.1%).
- Adult composite survey respondents with an education level of 8th grade or less (84.4%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents with a post-graduate degree provided the lowest average rating (76.0%).
- Adult composite survey respondents who have been with their current medical provider for more than 10 years (85.5%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents who have been with their current medical provider for less than 1 year provided the lowest average rating (73.0%).
- Adult composite survey respondents with four (4) visits to their medical provider within the past year (85.9%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents who have not seen their medical provider within the past year provided the lowest average rating (76.1%).

Key Study Findings - Child

- Child survey respondents in the control group provided higher ratings for all eleven (11) characteristics rated in the PCPCM survey as compared to children in the composite group.
- Among the child composite group, the average score across all eleven (11) characteristics was 85.3%, while the average score among child control group respondents was 90.4%.
- Child composite survey respondents provided the highest rating for “my practice is able to provide most of my care” (91.7%), while the lowest rated characteristic was “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (69.0%).
- Child control group survey respondents provided the highest rating for “my practice is able to provide most of my care” (95.7%), while the lowest rated characteristic was “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (79.9%).
- The largest increase in scores for the child control group over the composite group was recorded for “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (79.9% versus 69.0%).
- Among child composite survey respondents, the provider office receiving the highest average score across all eleven (11) characteristics was Hartford HealthCare Medical Group (92.4%), while the lowest average score was recorded for Community Health Center (77.8%).

Key Study Findings - Child

- Child composite survey respondents ages 5-9 (86.0%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents less than 1 year old provided the lowest average rating (80.0%).
- Boys in the child composite survey (85.7%) provided a slightly higher average rating as compared to girls (85.1%).
- Asian respondents in the child composite survey (88.3%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents characterizing themselves as an “other” ethnicity provided the lowest average rating (81.6%).
- Child composite survey respondents who have been with their current medical provider for more than 10 years (88.7%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents who have been with their current medical provider for less than 1 year provided the lowest average rating (79.2%).
- Child composite survey respondents with five (5) visits to their medical provider within the past year (90.4%) provided the highest overall average rating, while respondents who have not seen their medical provider within the past year provided the lowest average rating (76.4%).

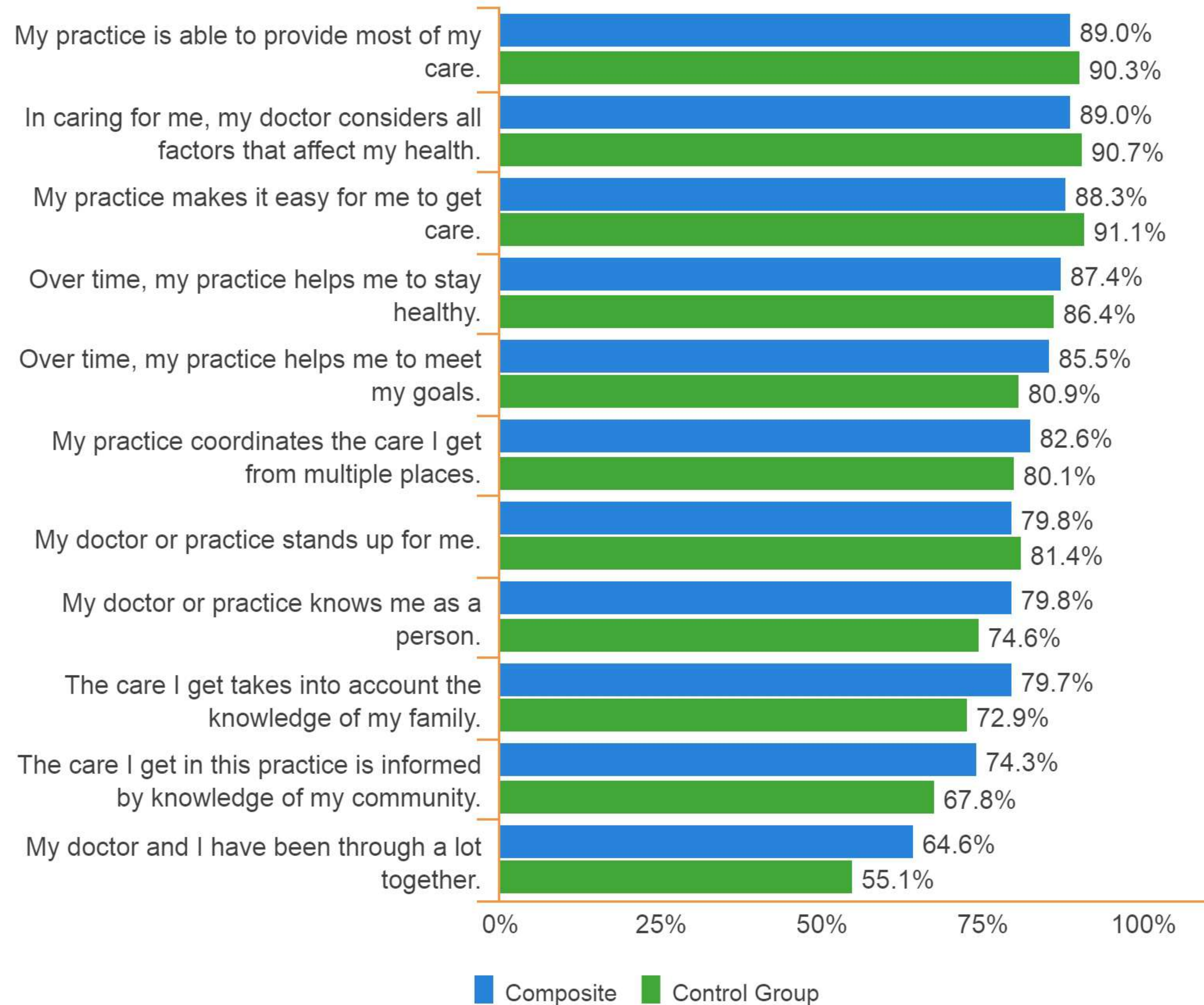

Adult Primary Care Experience

Survey respondents in the composite group provided higher ratings for seven (7) of eleven (11) characteristics rated in the PCPCM survey as compared to the control group.

The largest increase in scores for the composite group over the control group was recorded for “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (64.6% versus 55.1%), while the largest increase in scores for the control group over the composite group was recorded for “my practice makes it easy for me to get care” (91.1% versus 88.3%).

Adult Primary Care Experience - Composite

Among the composite group, the average score across all eleven (11) characteristics was 81.8%. The highest rated characteristics in the PCPCM survey were recorded for “my practice is able to provide most of my care” (89.0%) and “in caring for me, my doctor considers all factors that affect my health” (89.0%), while the lowest rated characteristic was “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (64.6%).

Adult Primary Care Experience - Control

Among the control group, the average score across all eleven (11) characteristics was 79.2%. The highest rated characteristic in the PCPCM survey was recorded for “my practice makes it easy for me to get care” (91.1%), while the lowest rated characteristic was “my doctor and I have been through a lot together” (55.1%).

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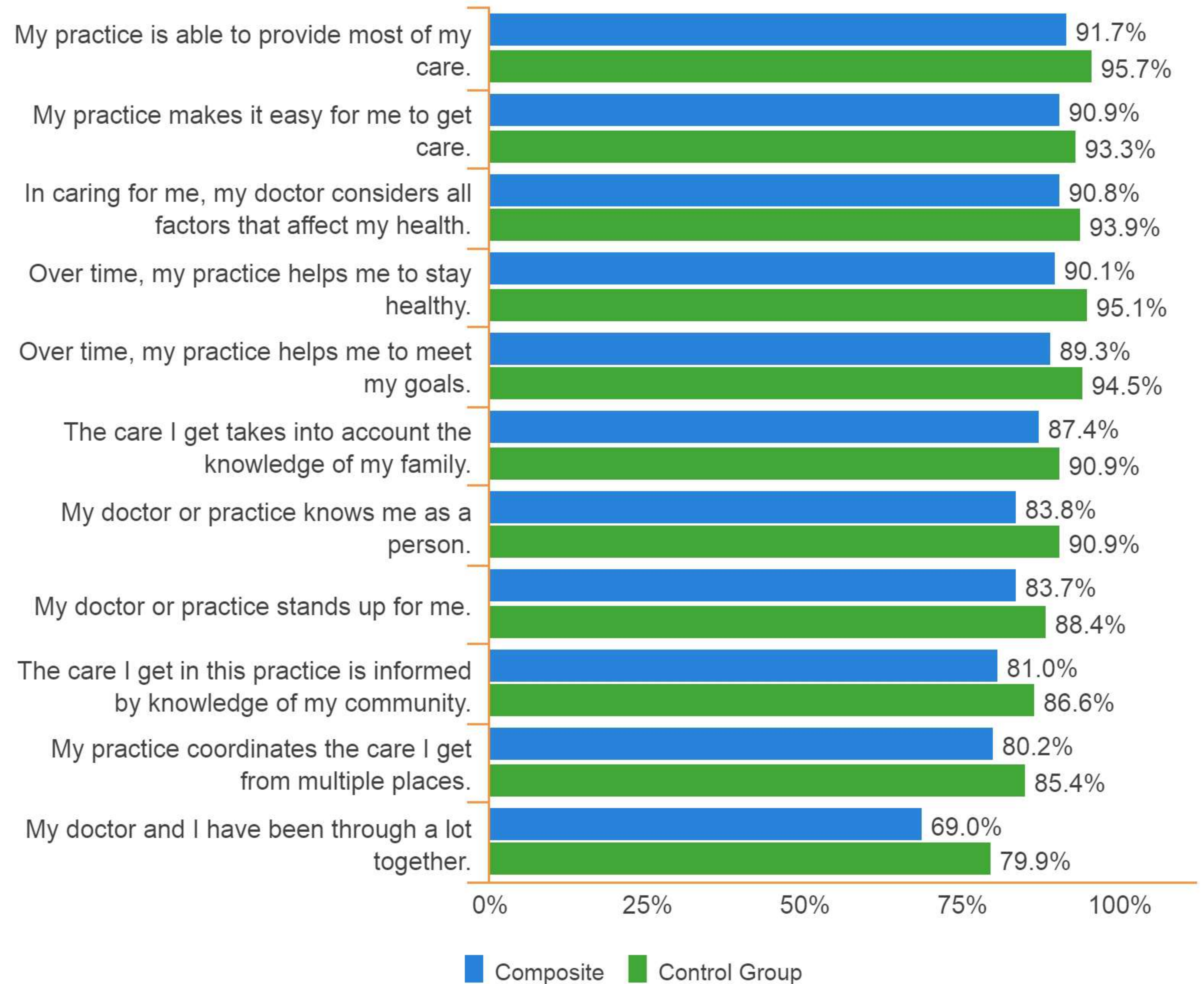
