Primary Care Program Advisory FQHC Subcommittee	Newly established subcommittee that will advise on FQHC-specific program design topics	Representatives from each FQHC	Monthly, following PCPAC meetings
MAPOC Care Management Committee	Ongoing updates to and engagement with MAPOC Care Management Committee	Existing forum	Established cadence, every other month
Non-FQHC Primary Care Provider Subcommittee	As needed forum for primary care provider engagement	Broad-based forum for Medicaid primary care providers	TBD, as needed

# Update: Key Stakeholder Feedback

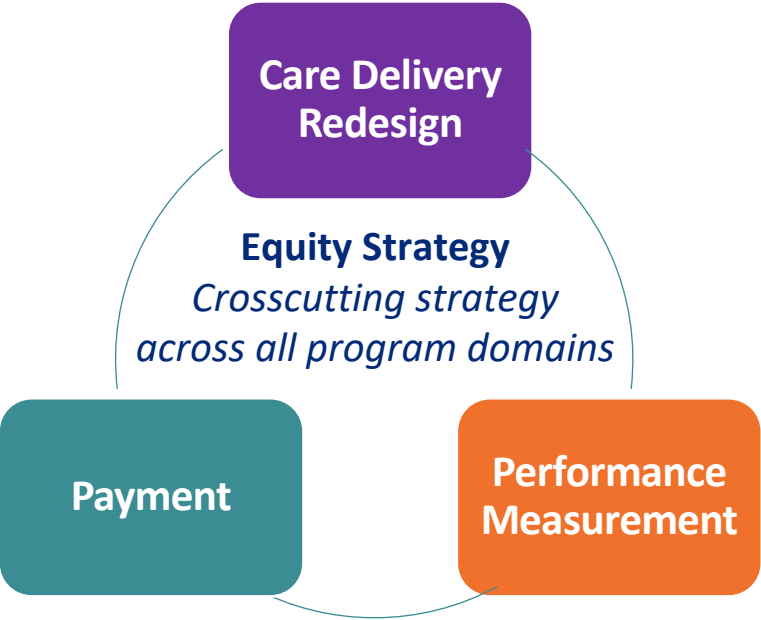
We have received valuable feedback from stakeholders in the initial meetings of both groups and are making adjustments to the process accordingly.

	Stakeholder Feedback	Response
Goals & Strategies	Provide committee members more opportunity to weigh in on the goals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Engaged in more discussion of the goals and provided clarifying definitions</li></ul>
Scope	Expand the scope of work to encompass an overall Medicaid strategy, inclusive of community infrastructure to address HRSN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Reframed this work in the context of broader strategies to address HRSN; will be seeking input regarding broader strategies</li></ul>
Timeline	Extend the timeline for program design work; allow more time to engage, don't rush	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Revised timeline to target program launch as of January 2025, instead of July 2024</li></ul>
Data & Evidence	Spend more time orienting committee members to the prior work (i.e., program data & evidence)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Spent time with both committees reviewing and answering questions about data and evidence base</li></ul>
Records	Distribute meeting minutes and create a central repository for meeting materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>A webpage for PCPAC meeting materials has been created: <a href="#">Primary Care Redesign - PCPAC Webpage</a></li></ul>
FQHC Topics	Provide the FQHC subcommittee the opportunity to further discuss FQHC specific concerns (e.g., dental integration, VBP models of interest)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Planning to use upcoming meeting of the FQHC subcommittee to engage in more discussion of FQHC specific concerns</li></ul>
