Recruitment Process

CHNCT reviews all Non-PCMH primary care practices for eligibility into the DSS PCMH program and outreaches them annually.

The primary reasons for non-participation in the PCMH program include:

- Practice doesn't use an EHR or doesn't have the reporting capabilities within their EHR
- Small HUSKY Health membership attribution
 - Most of these practices have less than 100 members
 - There are 50 practices (17%) that have an attribution of more than 500 members
- Perceived limited ROI due to the resources required to meet NCQA's or TJC's PCMH recognition status

Contact with Practices

- □ The staff reviews practice measure data from the practice's Annual Profile report, claims and practice EHR reports during Q1 of each year.
- □ CPTS staff are required to meet with their assigned practices (FQHC/PCMH/Glide Path) quarterly. Many practices request monthly meetings.
- □ The CPTS helps practices choose measures to improve for the calendar year.
 - Measures are chosen based on low percentile rates (less than 50%).
 - These chosen measures are considered 'engaged measures'.
 - Measure resources, best practices, and improvement recommendations are shared with the practices.
 - Practices may choose not to engage due to limited resources, staffing issues, or lack of incentive associated with a measure.

Measure Tracking

- The CPTS monitors the practice's chosen measures, rates, processes, planned practice interventions and barriers to implementation and improvement.
- □ The staff uses the Plan-Do-Study-Act (PDSA) model for QI with the practices.

Dashboard Review

- CHNCT has developed an internal dashboard that provides current year to date measure rates with only a two month claims lag.
- □ The dashboard rates are reviewed with the practices at each QI meeting.
- □ Practices are provided a spreadsheet or power point with their current measure rates.

CPTS Practice QI Engagement

Measurement year (MY) 2023 Results¹

□ 69 PCMH practices

Improved 32 different measures

□ 3% - 67.1%

MY 2024 Year to Date Results²

□ Thirteen FQHC practices (76%) engaged with their CPTS on measures for QI

□ Sixty-Nine PCMH practices (76%) engaged with their CPTS on measures for QI

□ Eight Glide Path practices (89%) engaged with their CPTS on measures for QI
