## **Select Project Inventory Update**

- 1. Non-emergency medical transportation Request for Proposals (RFP): procurement is scheduled to be released in March 2022
- 2. Covered CT: 1115 Demonstration Waiver: March 11<sup>th</sup> marks the final day for public comment. DSS will be requesting a final hearing with committees of cognizance requesting approval to submit the waiver to CMS
- 3. Fiscal Intermediary RFP: proposals are due to the Department on March 24th
- 4. CT Housing Engagement and Support Services (CHESS)

  - Outreach to 946 individuals predicted to meet eligibility criteria
  - 952 applications received of which 839 were forwarded to Beacon for eligibility verification
  - 146 meet eligibility criteria and are working with a supportive housing provider
  - 78 have an approved person-centered recovery plan
