Connecticut has the following Demonstration Waivers - pending activity

- 1. Substance Use Disorder Demonstration Waiver: no pending amendments
- 2. Covered CT: future amendment submission to limit out-of-network coverage per state statute
- 3. Justice-Involved Demonstration Waiver: awaiting CMS approval; DSS checking in with CMS weekly



The U.S. House Budget Committee circulated a <u>draft list</u> of potential reconciliation options, including the following related to Medicaid:

- 1. Per Capita Block Grant for Medicaid
- 2. Reduce Federal Match on Expansion Population (HUSKY D)
- 3. Reduce Federal Match on Floor/Minimum Rate (Currently 50%)
- 4. Reduce Medicaid Provider Tax Safe Harbor Threshold (Currently 6%)
- 5. Impose Penalties for Using State-Only Funds for Services Not Federally Sanctioned (e.g., noncitizen healthcare coverage)
- 6. Impose Work Requirements
