PA 25-42 An Act Concerning The Katie Beckett Working Group Recommendations	January 1, 2026 – DSS to post various info to DSS website October 1, 2026 – Legislative report submitted to CGA	
PA 25-63 An Act Requiring Medicaid Coverage for FDA-Approved Gene Therapies to Treat Sickle Cell Disease	Effective from Passage January 1, 2026 – Legislative report to CGA	
PA 25-89 An Act Concerning Autism and Intellectual Disability Services and Abuse and Neglect Investigations	Effective from Passage – DSS shall apply for funding to conduct statewide autism needs assessment	
PA 25-167 An Act Implementing Recommendations of the Bipartisan Drug Task Force	Effective from Passage – DSS shall petition HHS to authorize lower cost forms of GLP-1 prescription drugs	



Public Act 25-168	Implementation Requirement
Section 328 – DSS to collect data on the use of GLP-1 drugs in the Medicaid program	DSS shall report to the CGA by January 15, 2026, and annually thereafter
Section 341 – Requires DSS to distribute information on Medicaid coverage for breast prostheses, including information on coverage for persons enrolled in Medicaid	Effective from passage, DSS shall develop a provider bulletin and informational materials for persons enrolled in the Medicaid program
Section 47 – DSS shall develop a methodology for one or more financing structures or alternative payment methodologies for hospital services	DSS shall report to the CGA by January 31, 2026, on a methodology and implementation plan
Section 167 – Allows DSS to develop a quality metrics program to provide payments to nursing home facilities	DSS may establish program on or after October 1, 2026, within available appropriations. DSS shall report to the CGA by February 1, 2027 on implementation



State budget included:

- \$15.4 million for rate increases in FY 2026 and \$45 million in FY 2027
- HUSKY B expansion to include autism spectrum disorder treatment
- Rate increases for chronic disease hospitals: \$400,000
- Rate increase for home health medication admin. services: \$300,000
- Annualizes funding for children's urgent care centers: \$7.68 million (gross) to serve Medicaid members
- Removes shared savings component of the PCMH+ program in FY 2027
