To the Members of the Public Health Committee,

Thank you for giving me the opportunity to be heard. I am asking you all to consider the following:

1. When voting on the extension of the Governor's Executive Orders, please vote on each of the 11 orders individually. Issuing a bulk "yes" or "no" is unreasonable as the orders are very different and concern several different matters.

2. I am a Physician Assistant who sees children and adolescents in an emergency psychiatric setting. I can attest that the number of children I have seen in crisis with substance use, mental health issues, suicidal ideation and suicide attempts has been vastly higher these past two years than in the prior 13 years I have been in that setting combined. Masks, vaccines, social distancing and lockdowns have not stopped the virus but have collectively contributed to a vast mental health crisis in our children. We need to start learning to live with this virus and re-establish a sense of normalcy in the schools. Masks should not be considered the "new normal". We need to do better and we can start by making masks optional rather than mandatory.
