Dear Senators and Representatives,

Thank you for this opportunity to speak today. I wish it was in person in an official legislative session.

I have been listening all morning to the information that you will be basing your decision on. I have yet to hear a single statistic offered by the DPH to justify the continuation of the mitigation strategies that are being enforced in schools. I hope you have all read the latest Johns Hopkins meta-analysis that shows that all of the mitigation strategies that have been implemented during the pandemic nationwide have had only a miniscule amount positive benefit BUT AT WHAT COST!

Our representatives and senators are elected to their positions and our government is set up with a series of checks and balances. THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH is NOT.
