I am a 20 year resident of Greenwich, CT and I have raised two children here. My eldest is 20yo and my youngest is 14yo and a high school freshman at Greenwich Academy.

Since September of 2020, my youngest daughter has been able to attend school in-person thanks to the school's strict policy on mandating masks for all children pre-K to 12. All the correspondence I have received from the school regarding the mask mandate have made reference to "the state guidance and in compliance with the Governor's Executive Order".

My family and I are grateful that the state's guidance has been clear and unequivocal because it has allowed our school's policy to be clear, and based on science and best practices from the medical community.
