PURPOSE: To deliver patient care in a seamless system of services.

PROCEDURE:

Each of the two Divisions of Connecticut Valley Hospital (CVH), General Psychiatry and Addiction Services, has division-specific admission procedures which address:

- a. Pre-admission screening;
- b. Eligibility criteria for admission;
- c. Admission assessment; and
- d. Family and patient education.

Manuals which expand upon the specific procedures of each Division are located on each Unit within their respective Division.

1. General Psychiatry Division (GPD):

Patients are referred by a Local Mental Health Authority (LMHA) and screened through the Admission Office. Access to available beds is coordinated through the state-wide utilization management process.

2. Addiction Services Division (ASD):

There are four avenues of entry for clients.

- a. Voluntary admissions can be self-referred or referred through other human services agencies;
- b. Court referred clients are clients who have been screened by the DMHAS Court Liaison system and approved by the court to receive treatment in lieu of other legal consequences;
- c. Court committed clients are admitted via a state Superior Court; and
- d. Clients can also be admitted under a five-day Physician's Emergency Certificate if they are judged to be a danger to themselves or others.
