PURPOSE: It is the policy of Connecticut Valley Hospital (CVH) that all programs have adequate space to carry out the functions of the unit.

SCOPE: Director of Plant Operations; Division or Department Director(s); Discipline Supervisor; Supervisor of the Service Unit; Infection Prevention, and Plant Facilities Engineer

PROCEDURE:

At the time of renovations or relocation, a review of the space under consideration should include a discussion about current and potential space utilization and needs both within and between divisions, departments, and disciplines. This review will include the following individuals:

- a. Director of Plant Operations;
- b. Division or Department Director(s);
- c. Discipline Supervisor for areas dedicated to or under consideration for a particular discipline's activities;
- d. Supervisor of the Service Unit;
- e. Infection Prevention; and
- f. Plant Facilities Engineer.
