PT Equipment Procedure #9

Re: Standing Table

Date: March 20, 2000 Revised: October 19, 2008

Description:

Cutout table with an adjustable foot platform. The entire unit is placed on a wide base to prevent tipping. Door at back of unit opens to 180° for easy entering and exiting unit.

Indications:

Patients who require weight bearing in a safe environment, while also permitting upper extremity fine motor activity.

Precautions:

Patients with a history of Orthostatic Hypotension.

Procedure:

- 1. Open door of table.
- 2. Bring patient up to opening (evaluate height using adjustable platform if necessary).
- 3. Assist patient to stand in standing box.
- 4. Close door and fasten safety latch.
- 5. Observe posture and insert pillows as needed for support.
- 6. Set timer for duration of exercise treatment.
- 7. Check patient for tolerance every 5 minutes.
- 8. When time is completed, release latch and open door. Assist patient out of table.
- 9. Clean as per Physical Therapy Cleaning Procedures.
