<b>Update on Mock Survey</b>	<p>Dr. Pisano updated everyone on a couple of the findings from our mock survey that pertained specifically to credentialing and privileging.</p> <p>The first item is that he should not be doing the OPPE/FPPE for physicians who he is not in the same specialty as. There will have to be someone brought on-board or asked from the outside to do them.</p> <p>We need to develop better Telemedicine standards. There are three options that Dr. Pisano noted:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Full credentialing on our part. (Currently, we do this; however, we are out of compliance as we don't do OPPEs on them).</li> <li>2. Full credentialing on our part and accept the OPPE/FPPE from the source agency. (If Joint Commission Certified).</li> <li>3. Accept source agency credentialing and privileging and send them an OPPE/FPPE evaluation every six months for their files.</li> </ol>	These items need further discussion.	Dr. Pisano
<b>Suboxone Prescribing for ASD and ASD On-call Providers</b>	The issue was brought up that we need to track those doctors who are able to prescribe Suboxone.
